**Historical Note:**

The Anderson House was built in 1853 by Oliver Anderson. Anderson was born in Kentucky in 1794. The house served as a field hospital for the injured for Civil War combatants fighting in the Battle of Lexington. The property was donated to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources in 1858. The property currently is the Battle of Lexington State Historic Site.
