### **Historical Note:**

David Presbury Clark (1907-1995) was born in Missouri to Edward Payson Clark Jr. (1870-1938) and Florence Daisy Moore (1872-1945). He worked in a variety of architectural positions

throughout his life around the state. Notably, he worked for Berry McAlester in the late 1920s, Deering & Clark from 1933-1942, and was the manager of his own firm from 1946-1960, the architect for the state of Missouri from 1960-1979, and the architect inspector of hospitals and nursing homes in Missouri from 1966-1977 before retiring in 1979. Clark spent ten years on Columbia's Planning and Zoning Commission, five years on the Zoning Adjustment Board, and was chairman of the first Columbia Building Code Committee. He was also a member of the American Institute of Architects, past president of the Missouri Association of Registered Architects, a member of MU's School of Forestry, Fisheries, and Wildlife advisory council, and active in the Acacia Masonic Lodge, Moolah Temple, and the Lions Club.

Clark married his wife Ethel Melloway (1909-2004) in 1931, and they had two sons--Donald R. (1933-2003) and Stephen E. (1943-2010). Clark died on November 2, 1995.

### **Scope and Content Note:**

#### **Project files**

This series includes architectural specifications, correspondence, photostat images, photographs, contracts and bids, and financial information surrounding projects from the firms of Berry McAlester, Deering & Clark, and Dave P. Clark. Files are organized by firm and then subsequently by project number or chronologically, 1928-1985. *Note: all locations are in Columbia, MO, unless otherwise indicated.*

#### **Office files**

This series holds architectural firm administrative materials such as planners, contact and appointment books, job summaries and inventories, and financial information. Also included are papers from Clark's period as architect inspector of hospitals and nursing homes, his involvement with planning and zoning in the city of Columbia, speaking engagements, coursework and continuing education, and news clippings mentioning his projects. Files are arranged by type or topic and then chronologically.

#### **Personal papers**

This series consists of papers surrounding Clark's involvement with the University of Missouri-Columbia's School of Forestry, Fishery, and Wildlife advisory council from 1980-1982, such as correspondence, agendas and minutes, and handwritten notes. Arranged in original order, 1980-1982.

#### **Oversize architectural drawings**

This series contains the original architectural drawings (floorplans, mechanical specifications, artwork, etc.) as well as some blueprint copies of many of the building projects included in the first series of this collection. Arranged by firm and then subsequently by project number or chronologically, 1922-1985. *Note: all drawings are originals unless otherwise noted with a (b) for blueprint; similarly, locations are in Columbia, MO, unless otherwise indicated.*

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
