INTRODUCTION

The records of Dunklin County, Missouri Marriage Records, 1899-1908 contain a photocopy of the book <u>Records of Marriages</u>, for Dunklin County, recorded by R.M. Harris, Justice of the Peace.

DONOR INFORMATION

The records were donated to the University of Missouri by Sharon Thompson on 1 July 2004 (Accession No. RA1057). The original book was photocopied by the Office of the Secretary of State – Missouri and a copy was placed in the archives reference room. The original book was returned to the Dunklin County Clerk's office.

BIOGRAPHICAL

Dunklin County makes up the western side of Missouri's bootheel region. The Holcomb Township is located in the center of the county. Robert M. Harris (1857-1909) was a resident and served as Justice of the Peace in Holcomb Township in Dunklin County from 1895 to 1905.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The records contain 73 pages of marriages records ranging from March 1899 to December 1908. Most of the marriages involved residents of Dunklin County, the majority of which lived in Holcomb Township. Each record entry includes the names of participants, place of residents, date of marriage application, date of marriage, and the date the marriage was recorded.
