Officer Kindervater # 5115 is a certified moving and stationary Doppler radar operator in the State of Maryland. The radar unit was checked before and after the stop and found to be working properly. The unit is certified as accurate by Baltimore County Electronics Services. They maintain records of the internal calibration at their Hunt Valley facility.

On 3-18-15 at approximately 0154 hours Officer Kindervater was in unmarked patrol unit 1456 traveling southbound on Dulaney Valley Rd. passing the entrance to Towson Town Center (In front of Macy's). Officer Kindervater observed a vehicle traveling northbound on Dulaney Valley Rd. (From the roundabout) at a high rate of speed. The vehicle entered the influence of the radar at 55 MPH in a clearly posted 30 MPH zone. Officer Kindervater turned around and was finally able to catch up to the blue Ford Mustang bearing Maryland temporary registration 380314T near Locustvale Rd. Officer Kindervater observed the Ford Mustang was straddling the divided white lane lines for lanes two and one. Officer Kindervater activated his emergency equipment and stopped the vehicle near Interstate 695 on Dulaney Valley Rd.

The male driver looked at Officer Kindervater with a confused look and slurred "What did I do again?" Officer Kindervater detected an odor **of an alcoholic bever**age from **his breath. He noticed** his eye**s were** glassy. bloodshot and his pupils were dilated. Officer Kindervater again explained why he stopped the male driver and again asked for his license and registration. The male driver slurred "Wow, ok can you point your flash light in the back seat so I can get my wallet?" The male located his wallet from the rear seat and fumbled opening the wallet up. Officer Kindervater asked the defendant to step out of the vehicle to perform field sobriety tests. The defendant slurred "Yeah sure Officer." The defendant placed his right hand on the driver's door and his left hand on the driver's seat for support while exiting. Officer Kindervater asked defendant Pierce what kind of alcoholic beverages he consumed. Defendant Pierce slurred "Three shots of Jack."

The battery of tests performed by the defendant was the Horizontal Gaze

- -The defendant displayed Nystagmus Onset Prior to 45 Degrees in both eyes.
- The defendant displayed Vertical Nystagmus in both eyes.

- -Prior to this test the defendant's eyes were checked and found to be tracking equally and have equal-sized, dilated pupils.
