SABIR GUSEIN-ZADE - 60



The date of July 29, 2010 is the 60th anniversary of doctor in physics-mathematics sciences, Professor Sabir Gusein-Zade, the member of the International Advisory Board of "TWMS Journal of Pure and Applied Mathematics". Sabir Gusein-Zade was born in 1950 in Moscow. In 1971 he was graduated from Lomonosov Moscow State University. S. Gusein-Zade got his Ph.D. degree in 1975 and Doctor of Sciences degree in 1991 at Moscow State University.

He is a well known specialist in the fields of Singularity Theory, Algebraic Geometry, Topology and Applied Mathematics. S.Gusein-Zade was a Visiting Researcher and Visiting Professor at a number of foreign universities. S. Gusein-Zade has more than 160 papers (approximately 100 in pure and 65 in applied mathematics, correspondingly). Since 1996 he is a professor at the Department of Mechanics and Mathematics in Moscow State University. He is also a professor of Independent University of Moscow. S.Gusein-Zade is a member of the Editorial Boards of several Russian and international mathematical journals. Since 2008 he is one of Editors-in-Chief of the Moscow Mathematical Journal.

ALTAY BORUBAEV- 60



31 December 2010 is the 60th anniversary of doctor in physics-mathematics sciences, the president of Kyrgyz Mathematical Society, Chief of Supreme Attestation Commission of Kyrgyz Republic, Professor Altay Borubaev. Altay Borubaev was born in 1950 in the Talas region of Kyrgyz Republic. In 1972 he graduated from Kyrgyz State University. A. Borubaev got his Ph.D. degree in 1977 in Tbilisi (Georgia) and Doctor of Sciences degree in 1991 at Lomonosov Moscow State University.

He founded the scientific topology school in Central Asia. In 2001 A. Borubaev was elected a member of the National Academy of Sciences of Kyrgyz Republic. He was a Visiting Professor at a number of foreign universities such as universities of Moscow, Paris, London, Prague, Budapest, Turin, Manchester and Deli. Altay Borubaev has more than 120 papers, published in 17 countries, 5 monographs, 6 books. He is a member of the Editorial Boards of several national and international mathematical journals.
