## YOUR LEGISLATORS' VOTING RECORD ON SMALL BUSINESS ISSUES | 2022 EDITION

Votes by your state legislators on key small business issues are listed here. Although this Voting Record does not reflect all elements considered by a lawmaker when voting, nor does it represent a complete profile of a legislator, it can be a guide in evaluating your legislator's attitudes toward small business. Please thank those legislators who supported small business.

### BOTH CHAMBERS

- 1. Paycheck Protection Program Loans (2021-HB 278)** Allows the deduction of expenses paid with PPP forgiven loan proceeds to avoid the loan funds from being taxable income. **A "YES" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 33-0. Passed the House 89-3. Signed by the governor.
- 2. Regional Development Agency Fund (2021-HB382)** Bill was amended to include language that allowed the use of federal ARPA funds to pay off the loan balance for the Unemployment Insurance Fund, saving employers over one half billion dollars. **A "YES" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 36-1. Passed the House 90-3. Signed by the governor.
- 3. An Act related to Emergencies (2021-SB 5)** Provides liability protection for businesses from COVID lawsuits from both the public and employees. **A "YES" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 24-14. Passed the House 70-27. Became law without the governor's signature.
- 4. Unemployment Insurance (2022-HB4)** Revises Unemployment Insurance eligibility and benefits based on local unemployment rates and area wages to encourage return to work. **A "YES" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 22-13. Passed the House 58-36. Vetoed by the governor and overridden by the Legislature.
- 5. Valuation of Motor Vehicles (2022-HB6)** Freezes motor vehicle valuation at the 2019 figures to avoid 40% increase in property tax due to current high market value of used vehicles. **A "YES" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 34-0. Passed the House 91-0. Signed by the governor.
- 6. Employee Child Care Assistance (2022-HB499)** Voluntary program for matching funds for employers providing childcare assistance to encourage return to work. NFIB removed one section that would have allowed Economic Development Cabinet to require all businesses receiving incentives to participate. **A "YES" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 33-3. Passed the House 86-4. Signed by governor.
- 7. Economic Development (2022-HB594)** Bill creates the Kentucky REINS act, requiring agencies to consider economic impact on businesses for each new regulation. Provides more oversight to the General Assembly. **A "YES" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 26-9. Passed the House 71-22. Vetoed by the governor and overridden by the Legislature.
- 8. Termination of the COVID State of Emergency (SJR 150)** Binding resolution that ends all Emergency orders related to COVID pandemic and lifts remaining Executive Orders. **A "YES" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed the Senate 28-8. Passed the House 75-20. Vetoed by the governor and overridden by the Legislature.
