

### Crimea - Second-order administrative divisions

The first-order administrative divisions of Ukraine on the Crimean peninsula are the Autonomous Republic of Crimea (Автономна Республіка Крим; Avtonomna Respublika Krym) and Sevastopol City (Місто Севастополь; Misto Sevastopol). Sevastopol City is administered separately from the rest of Crimea; along with Kyiv, it is one of two special municipalities of Ukraine.

In July 2020 the Ukrainian government announced an administrative reform; in the terms of this reform, Ukraine laid out a simplified structure across the country, including Crimea, specifically, that the Autonomous Republic would be divided into 10 rayons at second-order administrative level, replacing the previous structure of 14 rayons and 11 cities directly subordinate to the republic. Misto Sevastopol no longer has any administrative rayons recorded within the municipality.

In the legal documentation surrounding this reform it was stated that these changes would not take place until the “return of the temporarily occupied territory of the Autonomous Republic of Crimea and the city of Sevastopol under the general jurisdiction of Ukraine”<sup>1</sup>, and as a result, PCGN did not immediately reflect this new structure. However, more recently it seems that Ukrainian sources, including the decentralization reform website, <https://atu.decentralization.gov.ua/#> and the 2021 national atlas do in fact show the new structure and therefore PCGN, alongside our US counterparts the US Board on Geographic Names, have decided to adopt the new structure across Crimea (as well as the rest of Ukraine).

As a sovereign part of Ukraine, it is HMG policy to reflect the names of Crimea in Ukrainian (romanized according to the BGN/PCGN agreed [Romanization System for Ukrainian](#)). For reference, the Russian/romanized Russian forms of the administrative centres are also included (shown in grey). These should not be shown on HMG products.

Also for reference, the previous structure, which will still be encountered on some sources, appears below on pages 3 and 4.
