CONDOR RUGBY FOOTBALL CLUB (INC.)

OUR STORY

In 1983, a group of rugby enthusiasts comprising administrators, coaches and players of club, provincial and All Black Rugby, came together and established a Rugby Club with its principal objective being to “promote and foster schoolboy and junior Rugby in New Zealand”.

The Condor Rugby Football Club, affectionately called the ‘Condors’ is a constituted Incorporated Society, with an active membership of approximately one hundred fulfilling this objective.

The Condor Rugby Football Club is a professional organization, with elected officers, well qualified to ensure all activities are of a high standard. Condors is grateful for the generosity of sponsors and charitable trusts who fund the annual national tournament. Over the years, with endeavours to generate maximum interest, tournament venues have ranged from Christchurch, Wellington, Palmerston North, Taupo, Rotorua, Hamilton and in most recent times, due to logistical considerations, in Auckland.

Early on, Condors committed to Secondary School Sevens, with the reason being many young men were initially involved in rugby at school, but then opted out of the game before they left school. Condors perceived this was to either follow other options or were removed from the game by parents concerned at the perceived, growing physicality of the 15-a-side game. A key objective of the Condors was to retain players within the Rugby fraternity by offering sevens as an alternative to the 15-a-side game. In more recent years, Condors has embraced the growth and opportunity in the women’s game with equal opportunity to play provided to schoolgirls.

With the approval of the School Sport NZ and New Zealand Rugby, Condors annually hosts the Condor Sevens National Secondary School Finals. A boys and girls tournament team is selected with players gaining an automatic nomination for the NZ Condors Teams that compete at the World Schools Tournament in December. Players receive an official Condors team photograph as confirmation of selection into the Condors Tournament Team and NZ Condors Sevens Teams.

The Condors ultimate objective is to have this Condor NZ Sevens team play an overseas Secondary Schools Sevens representative team, ideally as a curtain raiser to a Test Match.

Recent estimates indicate Condors tournaments have had over 30,000 young men and women compete. This creates opportunities for participants to further their rugby careers through the game of Sevens and has provided a pathway for many into the 15-a-side game also.

With Sevens featured at the 2016 Rio de Janeiro Olympic Games, and New Zealand’s continuing success on the IRB Sevens circuit, the Condor Rugby Football Club continues to provide an outlet for further growth in the future.

CONDOR CHAIR'S MESSAGE

A very warm welcome to you all.

Since our founding members formed the Condor RFC (Inc.) in 1983, and our very first Condor Sevens Nationals was hosted at Eden Park in 1986 with 16 boys' teams, the only incident we suffered was the cancellation of our 1999 tournament due to inclement weather which forced most outdoor events to be cancelled in Auckland that day.

The uncertainty of when we might be forced into another Covid-19 lockdown from March 2020 meant our planning was thrown into disarray several times, creating reservation about available funding from sponsors and gaming trusts alike however, we are extremely pleased that we were able to host this, our 34th National Secondary Schools Condor Sevens event at the prestigious King's College, Otahuhu in Auckland, once again.

This threat was ever present until the first kick was taken on Thursday 10 December, 2020 with Open Grade, and the referees whistle was blown to end the last U15 Final on Sunday 13 December, 2020.

In this regard we ask that all our stakeholders be mindful that this uncertainty will continue into 2021 until an extremely reliable, approved, and safe Covid-19 vaccine is discovered, and this vagueness has already affected our 2021 tournament, which we have moved from April 2021 to December 2021.

We had the great privilege of partnering again with Youthtown Inc. and are most fortunate indeed to have their support again in 2021. Our sincere thanks to Fay Amaral, CEO, and Amie Reynolds, Relationship Manager for their ongoing support.

Once again, we exceeded all expectations in terms of delivery of the 2020 Youthtown Condor Sevens tournament and without the generous support of Youthtown, this would have been extremely difficult.

We welcome sponsors, NZ Sport Collective, and Rob Waddell, along with key partners Sky Sport, Broadcast Sponsor (Live Coverage over 2 days), and Sky Sport Next, new Streaming Service Sponsor (4 fields over 2 days).

We trust all students, and their coaching staff who took part over the four-day finals had a positive experience, and I hope you will take away many fond memories of your participation at the Condor Sevens Finals event for 2020.

My thanks to all sponsors, gaming trusts, stakeholders, referees, parents/caregivers, supporters, and Condor staff and helpers who have, and will continue to contribute to the success of our next event in 2021 at King's College.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank Garry Carnachan, CEO, School Sport NZ for his continued support of Condor Sevens over many years and wish him all the very best for the next challenge he has chosen to pursue in the future. Ngā mihi nui ki a koe e te Rangatira e Garry.

I take this opportunity to advise that I will step down from my role as Condor Chairman, and warmly welcome Sonny Raina who will take on the role of Condors CEO, Operations, effective 1st March 2021. This re-designated role is due to changes in our organisation structure. My very best wishes to Sonny in this new role and I have every confidence that he will fill this role admirably.

Sonny will be in touch with key stakeholders over the next few months.

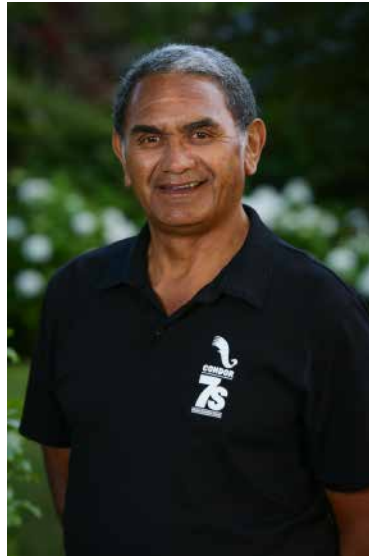

Our thanks to the following provincial unions for providing schools the opportunity to the pathway to the Condors. The qualification-based tournament for the opens division ensures a nation-wide representation with 32 boys and 24 girls teams competing for the Condors Cups.



The CONDOR 7s National Secondary Schools Rugby Sevens Finals has been running for 34 years and has grown from 16 teams in 2013 to 112 teams in 2020. Traditionally held in Auckland, although has been held throughout NZ, the tournament is delivered over four days across four divisions (Opens and U15 boys and girls). The U15 tournament is invitational and the Opens is qualification-based to ensure nation-wide representation. The Opens event is broadcast live on Sky Sport over two days and 291 games streamed live over the four days on the Sky Sport Next platform. The 35th edition of the tournament will be held at King's College in Auckland from 2 - 5 December 2021.
