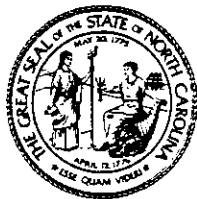

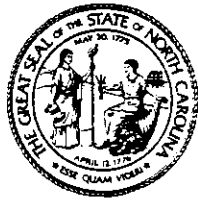

BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION
HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ORDINANCES

The Board of Transportation has delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 (f), (g) (see 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

Pursuant to that delegation, the Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation, and in accordance with General Statute 20-165.1.

US ROUTE CHANGES

DIVISION 6

COLUMBUS COUNTY

Delete the following routing of US 74-76 and add as a Secondary Road, east of Whiteville:

US 74-76 from US 74-76 Bus., eastward to existing NC 214 and existing SR 1735, in Lake Waccamaw.

Delete the following routing of US 74-76 and add as NC 214, in and east of Lake Waccamaw:

US 74-76 from existing NC 214 and existing SR 1735, eastward to Proposed US 74-76 (Project 8.1327804).

Delete the following routing of SR 1735 and add as NC 214, in and near Lake Waccamaw:

SR 1735 from existing US 74-76, northward to Proposed US 74-76 (Project 8.1327803).

Delete the following routing of NC 214 and add as a Secondary Road, in and east of Lake Waccamaw:

NC 214 from existing US 74-76, eastward to existing US 74-76.

COLUMBUS COUNTY - CONTINUED

Add the following routing of US 74-76, east of Whiteville:

US 74-76 along New Project 8.1327803 from US 74-76 Bus., eastward to existing SR 1735.

Add the following routing of US 74-76, near and east of Lake Waccamaw:


US 74-76 along New Project 8.1327804 from existing SR 1735, eastward to Proposed NC 214.




