Reasons for Notification:

This laneside cutting shows upper Ashdown Sand Formation (lower Hastings Beds Group) with siltstones and fine sandstones with sedimentary structures and 1 m-long *Lycopodites* plants in life position. It is one of only two occurrences of the latter known in Ashdown Sand (Waldron Soil Bed).

This is a key site for environmental interpretations in the Wealden.
