

Kern County certified their official canvass to the Secretary of State on December 8, 2022. On December 9, 2022, Kern County discovered ten uncounted ballots. On December 15, 2022, the Kern County Superior Court ordered Kern County to open the ten ballots and tabulate the votes therein by December 17, 2022, and include the results in the vote totals for the elections in the affected jurisdictions and issue a supplemental certification for those elections. Kern County updated their vote results to the Secretary of State on January 17, 2023. Kern County's vote totals for statewide contests, districts contests, and state propositions have been updated in this Statement of Vote to reflect their amended official canvass. While no election outcomes were affected, the vote counts have changed slightly for statewide contests, district contests that include Kern County, and state propositions.

### NOVEMBER 8, 2022, GENERAL ELECTION ABOUT THIS STATEMENT OF VOTE

The Statement of Vote reports the county-by-county votes cast for each candidate and measure on the ballot. In a statewide contest such as Governor, the vote is reported by all 58 counties and listed in alphabetical order with the statewide total at the bottom. Candidates are listed in alphabetical order by party, with the two major parties first (i.e., Democratic, Republican, American Independent, Green, Libertarian, and Peace and Freedom). For example:


