

Course Description: Students enrolled in an instrumental music class at Midland Middle School are learning to develop skills and abilities related to the performing art. These are courses designed for students given their current ability level and aptitude for performing music. Students enrolled will perform daily in class as a requirement, and at concerts periodically throughout the school year. These classes utilize the Georgia Standards of Excellence for Band & Orchestra in order to teach and improve student understanding and performance in this performing art.

Course Outline/Objectives: Each week throughout the year, the class will cover the following objectives: posture, playing position, breathing, tone quality, intonation, articulation, style, fingerings, syncopation, rhythm, rhythmic precision, dynamics, balance & blend, and phrasing. In addition students will have weekly musical vocabulary and theory lessons.

Band & Orchestra is a graded core academic subject.

25 points per week Daily Performance in Rehearsal (Lack of Participation results in loss of points)

50 points per week Weekly Practice Records (turned in weekly on Wed.)
100 points per test Playing Tests (Can be retaken during tutoring times)
100 points per test Written Tests (May be corrected and returned)

500 points per Concert Participation- The ensembles traditionally participate in two concerts

throughout the year, once in the winter and in the spring. Additional performances will be scheduled. A complete calendar will be distributed as the calendar is finalized.

Scheduled Help Sessions: Afterschool assistance may be suggested for students who are struggling with performance concepts. Sessions are also available for students seeking additional help to achieve a higher level. I make myself available until 6:00pm Thursdays and Fridays for any students requiring or requesting assistance. Students must inform me the day prior to ensure I am available.

Teacher/Parent Communication: Parents will be contacted by telephone or email. We are a community responsible for bringing up the students at Midland Middle School. I will phone or e-mail for any number of situations to include; excellence in the classroom performance, character, actions, or if a child is struggling with behavior, or performance.

MMS Band & Orchestra Procedures and Expectations

Procedures:

- 1. Be on time to class. Students who are not in the classroom by the bell will be marked tardy. Numerous tardies may result in discipline action by the administration.
- 2. Come prepared to class: instrument, books/music, supplies, **and best positive attitude**. Lack of materials or failure to participate will result in grade reduction.
- 3. Place instrument cases in band & orchestra locker (free of charge, no lock provided). Purses, Sling Bags, Library Books, and other materials not related to the class should be placed in the locker.
- 4. Be in your seat, with instrument assembled and Do-Now completed, within 3 min after the bell.
- 5. Participate throughout the class period; all instruction relates to everyone. Disruptions will not be tolerated in the band/orchestra room. Lack of Participation will result in grade reduction.
- 6. Take your instrument home nightly to practice. Practice Records will be collected every Wednesday showing 5 nights a week of 20 min practice sessions. Late Practice Records will not be accepted.

Expectations:

- 1. You will remain quiet and focused in class. Our class is one that is based upon your ability to hear instructions, so your quiet attentiveness is essential.
- 2. You will be prepared to learn. An instrument that is not ready to play is not helpful; make sure that you have everything you need in order to make beautiful music.
- 3. You will be respectful of the band & orchestra room and each other.
 Our instruments are all expensive, and we don't want them to break. Touch only your instrument.
- 4. Don't just practice till you play it right, practice until you can't play it wrong. The better you play the more fun you will have.
- 5. Instruments in disrepair should be taken to the music shop as quickly as possible.

Connections Community Norms:

- 1. Be Safe- Being safe within our building is paramount to a quality learning experience. We will be safe in the band & orchestra room when we are acknowledging and respecting others personal space, and property.
- Be Kind- Being kind is a skill that we must develop to be effective members of society. We will be kind in the band & orchestra room when we use good manners, words, and appropriate tone when speaking to others in the classroom.
- 3. Be Engaged- Staying focused and on task in the classroom will lead you to understand the content better. We will be engaged in the band & orchestra room when we are prepared for class and offer substance to the class atmosphere.

I believe that the music making experience is most closely related to family. We will rely on each other throughout the year to create beautiful and exiting music. I promise to bring every tool I have available to me to help you do that. I know you will do the same.
