1. INTRODUCTION

The way around this is to append a colon followed by a unique tag to each figure label. The value of the tag is ignored internally—it serves only to differentiate between the two figure labels on the L^AT_EX side.




Figure 1. This figure was generated by the script `mandelbrot.py` and is labeled `fig:mandelbrot:original`.




Figure 2. This figure was generated by the script `mandelbrot.py` and is labeled `fig:mandelbrot:red`.
