One of the things we try to do is bless ministries with resources. Over 6000 gospels, 700 Native NTs were donated


and over a dozen native Christian resources are provided to others to use in ministry.

My story becomes your story when it is all said and done. One day we will give an account to our Creator and Savior for the time, gifts and response to His Calling. The rewards will be crowns which will be cast at His feet.

After 8 1/2 years of school earning a MDIV from SWBTS and 30 years serving as a minister in 7 churches, I retired. But God had other plans. Five years ago I started Three Feathers Ministry - www.threefeathersministry.com - under Chapel Ministries, Inc. a 501c3. At United in Christ I was asked to create a website connecting Native Americans and ministries. Five years later we have connected 1300 Tribal Nations in the USA & Canada on 1178 Reservations, Reserves and Corporations with hundreds of resources for Native Nations, Schools and individuals plus hundreds of Christian Resources for Native Ministries.

# I try to provide resources for these needs: Quick Stats

American Indians and Alaska Natives are 2.5 times as likely to experience violent crimes and at least 2 times more likely to experience rape or sexual assault crimes compared to all other races.

- More than 4 in 5 American Indian and Alaska Native women, or 84.3 percent, have experienced violence in their lifetime.
- Homicide is the third leading cause of death among American Indian and Alaska Native women between 10 and 24 years of age and the 5th leading cause of death for American Indian and Alaska Native women between 25 and 34 years of age.
- In the U.S. and Canada, an average of 40 percent of the women who were victims of sex trafficking identified as American Indian or Alaskan Native.

Suicide is four times as high for teens through 24 years old. My heart hurts for the families who have to go through such heart wrenching loss.

So I just want to say thank you for helping me see the impossible done. Both of us will one day cast our crowns at the feet of Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior who is the Creator who came among us to ask us to walk His road with Him once we are forgiven. Will you help send me again. The doors are opening wide.
