## NOTES

The Inner London Education Authority is composed of 58 members - two for each of the 29 parliamentary constituencies in Inner London.

The next ordinary elections for members of the Authority are due to take place in 1990 (and every fourth year thereafter) and will be based on single member electoral divisions.

The estimates of total population and the population aged 18+ used in Table 2, relate to April 1986 and come from the 1985 round of London Borough projections (GLC Statistical Series 52). Since the projections were based upon official estimates relating to 1984 and there has been a recent decline in the levels of population loss from some boroughs it is possible that a borough may have more electors than the estimated population aged 18+.

The very high incidence of spoilt ballot papers in the election has prompted us to provide full information for all electoral divisions as part of Table 2.

The results of the London Borough elections, held on the same day as the ILEA election, have been used to illustrate the possible results of using two slightly different proposals for the new electoral divisions in Appendix A. The first proposal is based on the Local Government Boundary Commission ILEA Electoral Review - Draft Proposals, and the second on the ILEA's original submission to the Boundary Commission as detailed in a Report to the Education Committee, 14 January 1986.

Parties which did not contest all available seats in a borough in the borough elections will be under-represented in the estimates. This applies particularly to the Alliance Parties in Hackney, and to the Conservative Party in Southwark and Tower Hamlets.

The implied membership of the authority shown at the end of the Appendix is based on two members per constituency for the estimates grossed to parliamentary constituencies (LB) with both members drawn from the first party past the post, and one member per constituency for both single member constituency proposals (schemes 1 and 2).

The constituencies used in Appendix B were those in force at the Greater London Council Elections 7 May 1981, and are not comparable with any used elsewhere in this publication.
