

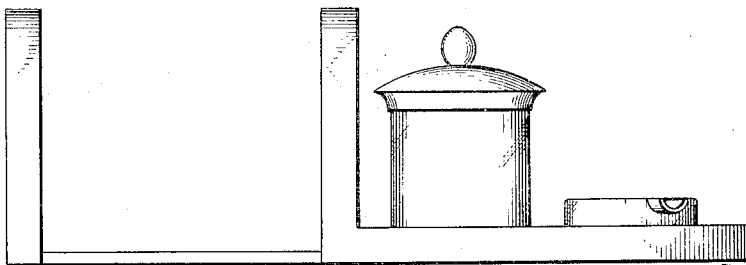
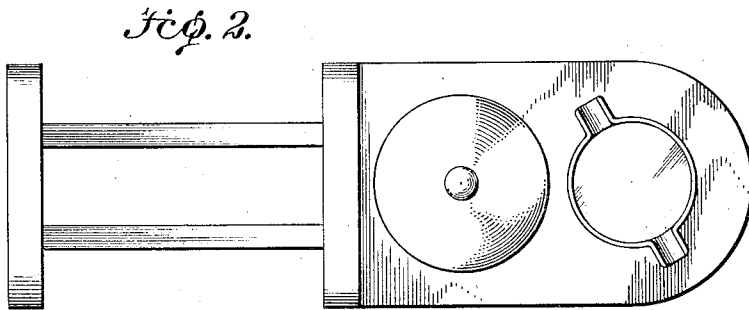
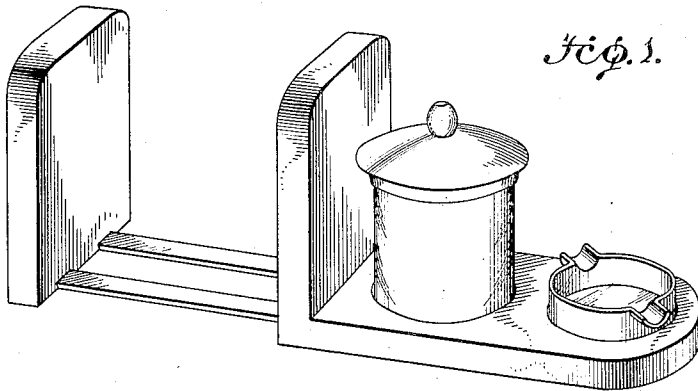

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Hamilton O. Cornwall, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combination Bookend, Humidor, and Ashtray, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
