FIG. 3 is an end elevation view opposite that shown in FIG. 2;

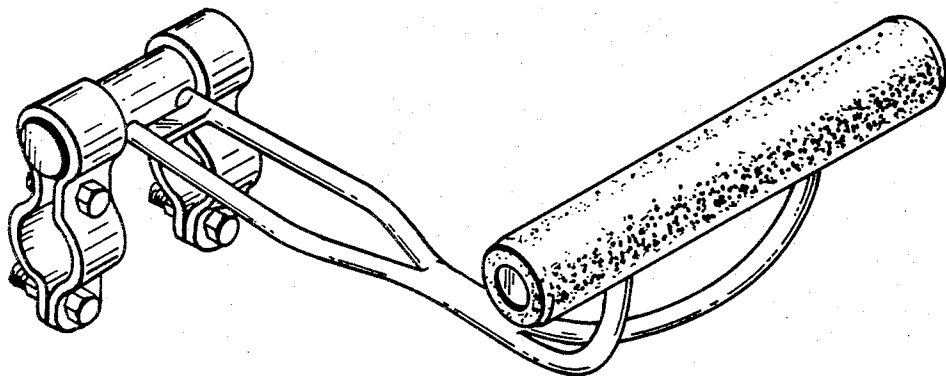
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

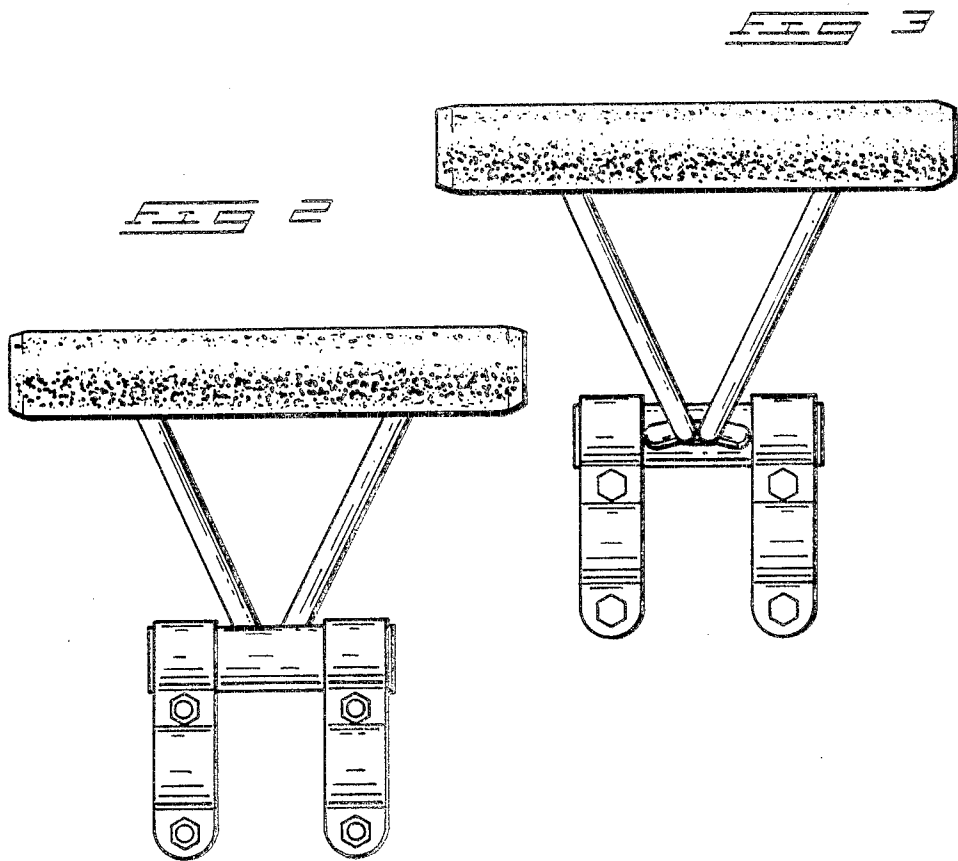
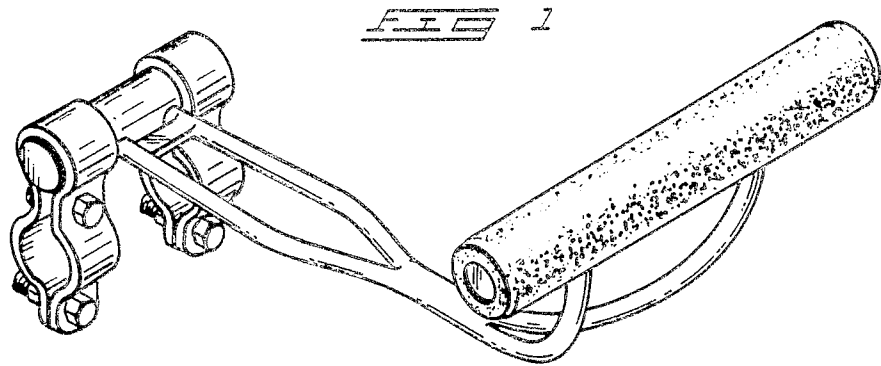

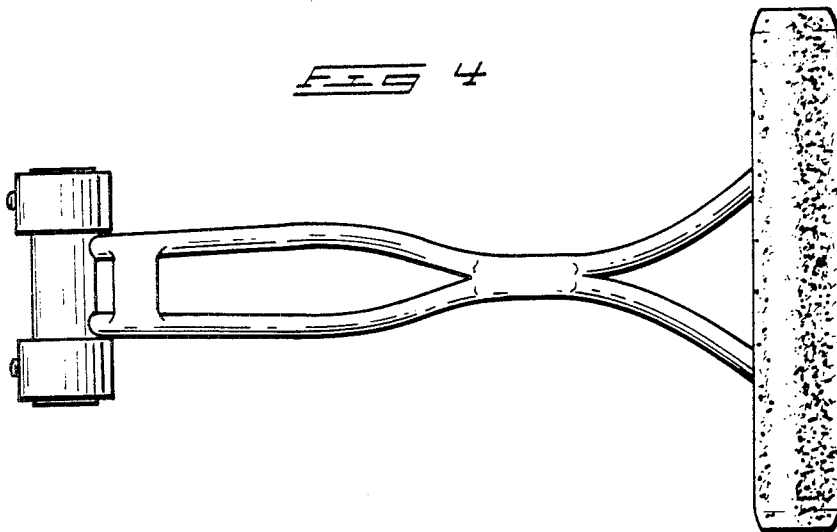
