The ornamental design for a dish for animals, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a dish for animals, showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being the same as the front shown;  
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and  
 FIG. 4 is a cross sectional view taken on line 4-4 of FIG. 1.

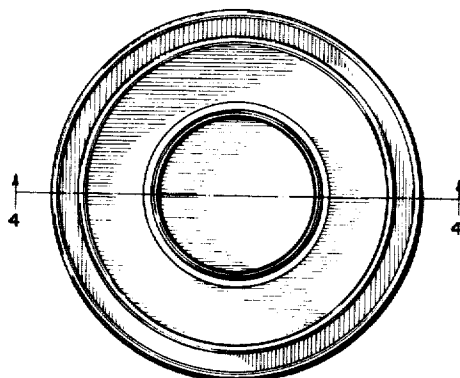

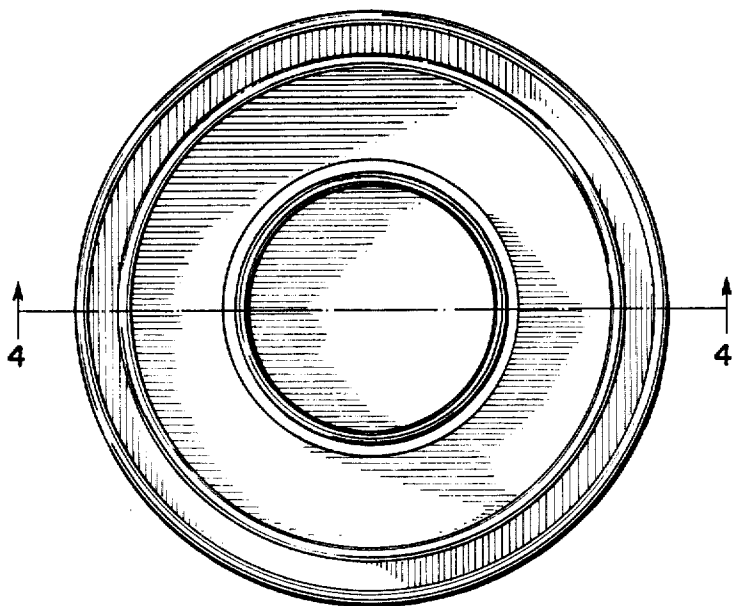

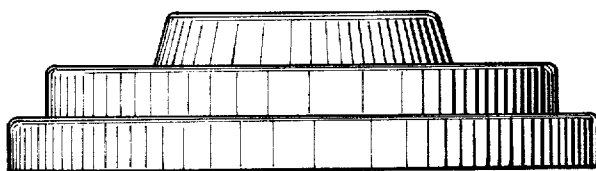

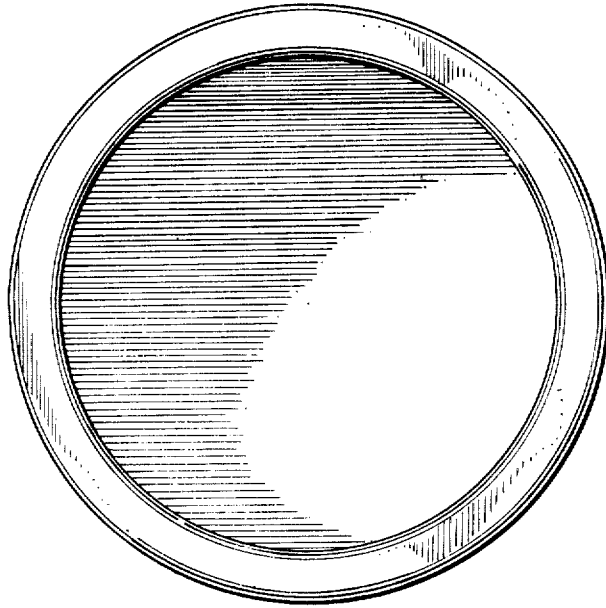
