To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Henry J. Landry, a citizen of the United States, residing at Thompsonville, in the county of Hartford and State of Connecticut, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Floor Covering or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The figure of the drawing is a plan view of

a floor covering or the like showing my design, a repeat unit of which is enclosed within a rectangle of dash lines, with an extension of the design on all four sides of the unit to indicate its relation to the surrounding units.
