[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined wristwatch and bracelet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an extended top plan view of a combined wristwatch and bracelet showing my new design; FIG. 2 is an extended bottom plan view thereof with the clasp ends turned 90°; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof in a curved, wrist-confirming position; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 3; FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 3; and FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 3.

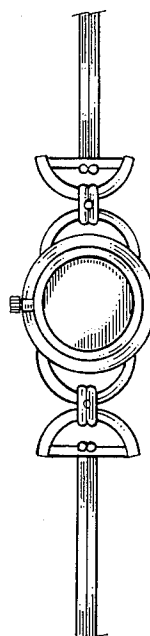

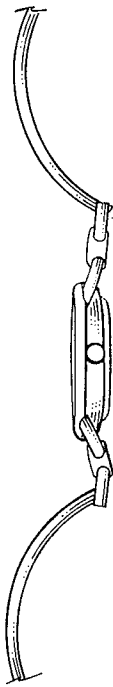

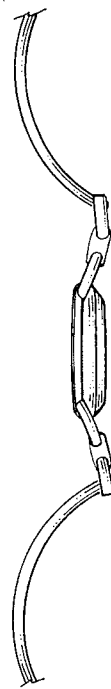

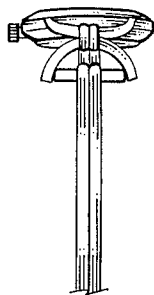

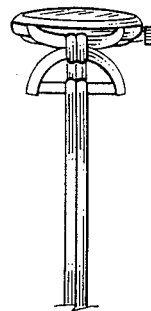
