

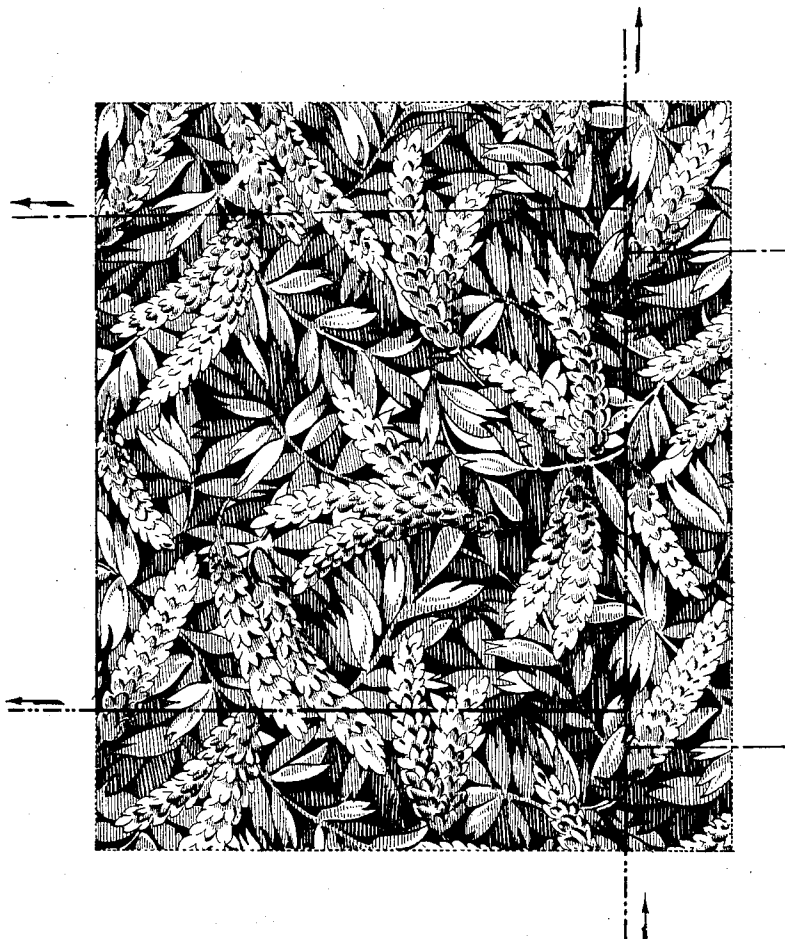

DESIGN FOR A TEXTILE FABRIC

Application filed March 20, 1930. Serial No. 34,979. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LINCOLN BARKER, a citizen of the United States, residing in New York, in the county of New York, State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Textile Fabric, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of a textile fabric showing my new design.

A single unit of my design is comprised within the area defined by the indicating arrows shown in the drawing.

I claim:
