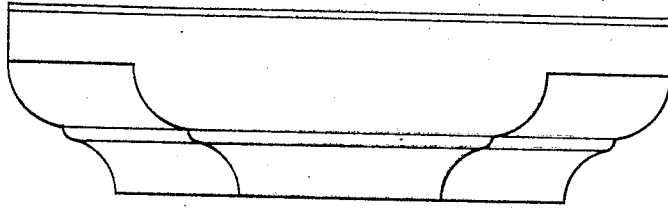

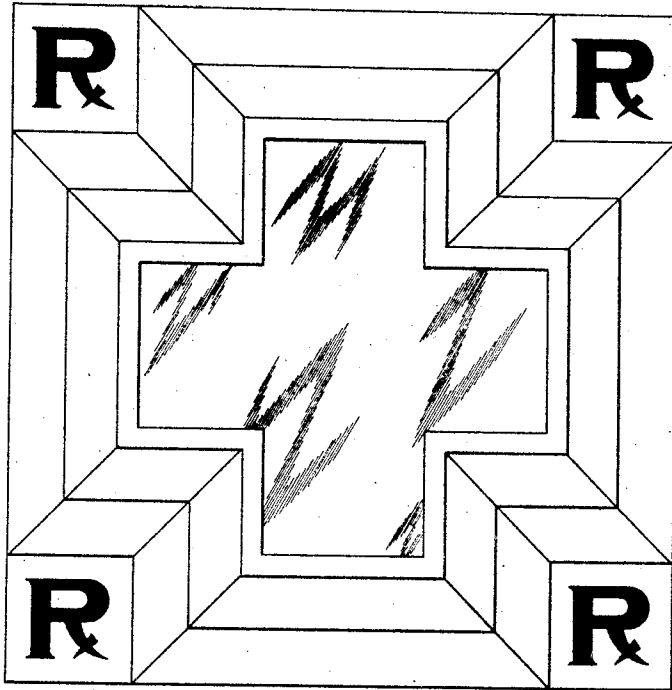

DESIGN FOR AN AUTOMOBILE LAMP.

Application filed April 16, 1926. Serial No. 17,315. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, MICHAEL E. COMISKEY, a citizen of the United States, residing at Boston, in the county of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Automobile Lamp, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
