[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a shoe outsole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a shoe outsole showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a side view of the shoe outsole shown in FIG. 1:

FIG. 3 is a side view of the other side of the shoe outsole shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a cross section taken along line 5—5 of FIG.

FIG. 6 is a cross section taken along line 6—6 of FIG.

FIG. 7 is a cross section taken along line 7—7 of FIG.

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of the shoe outsole shown in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view of the shoe outsole shown in FIG. 1.
