

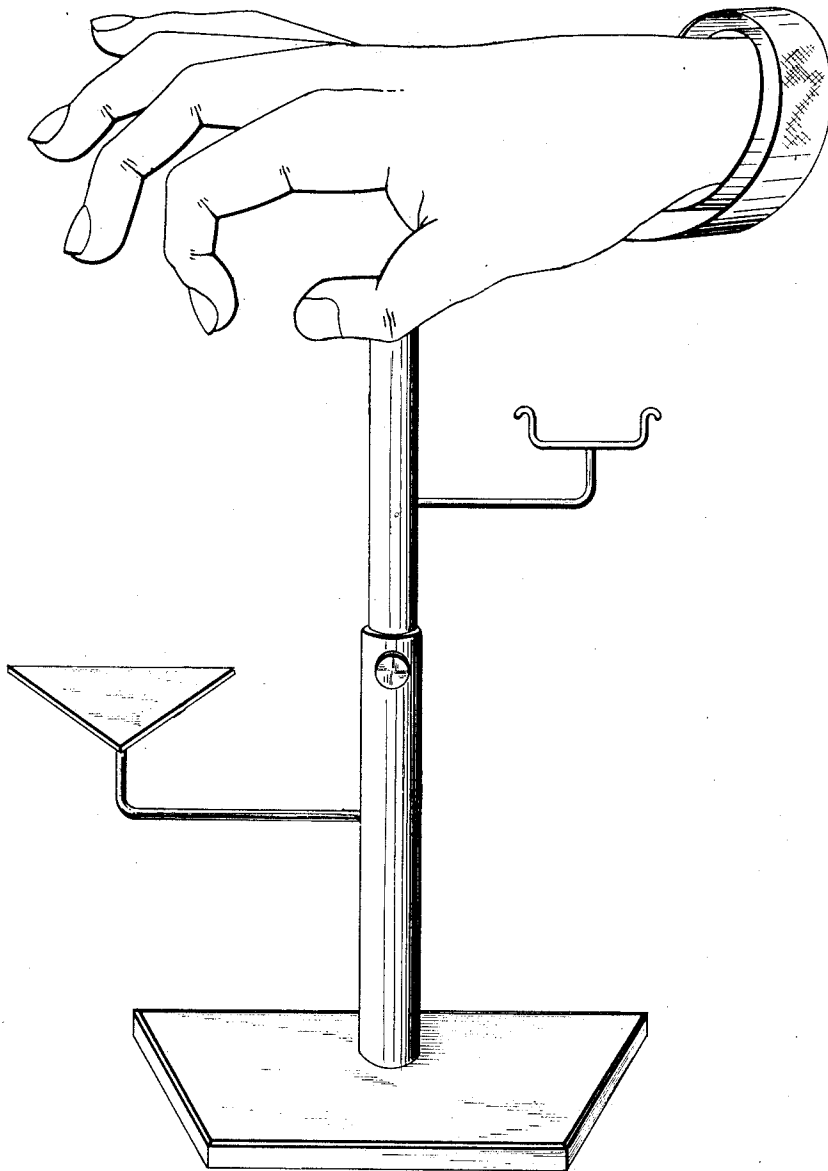

DESIGN FOR A DISPLAY FIXTURE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Louis Horwitz, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at New York, Bronx County, State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Display Fixture, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof and in which:

The figure is a perspective view of a display fixture showing my new design.

The device consists broadly in the simulation of a human hand mounted on the upper end of a post carried by a stand base, the hand being supported by the post or upright by securing the same in the hand.
