The ornamental design for electric violin, substantially as shown and described.

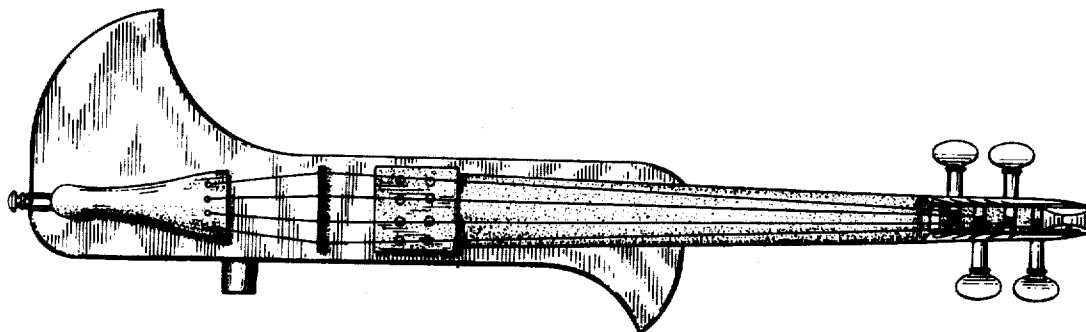
**DESCRIPTION**

 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view.

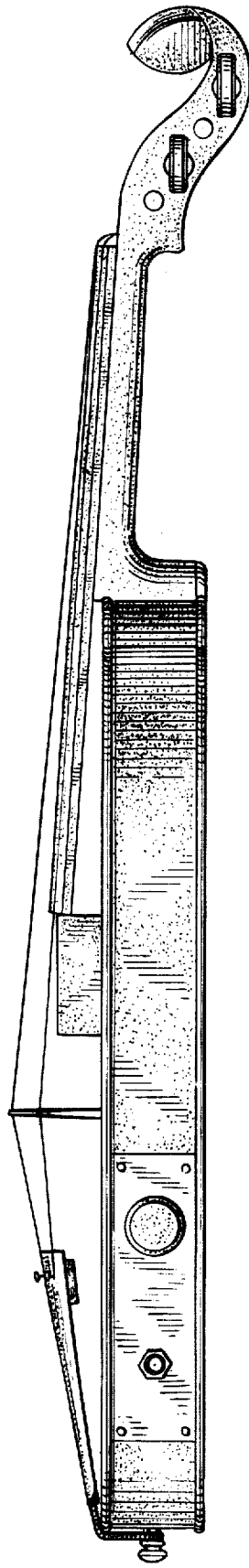
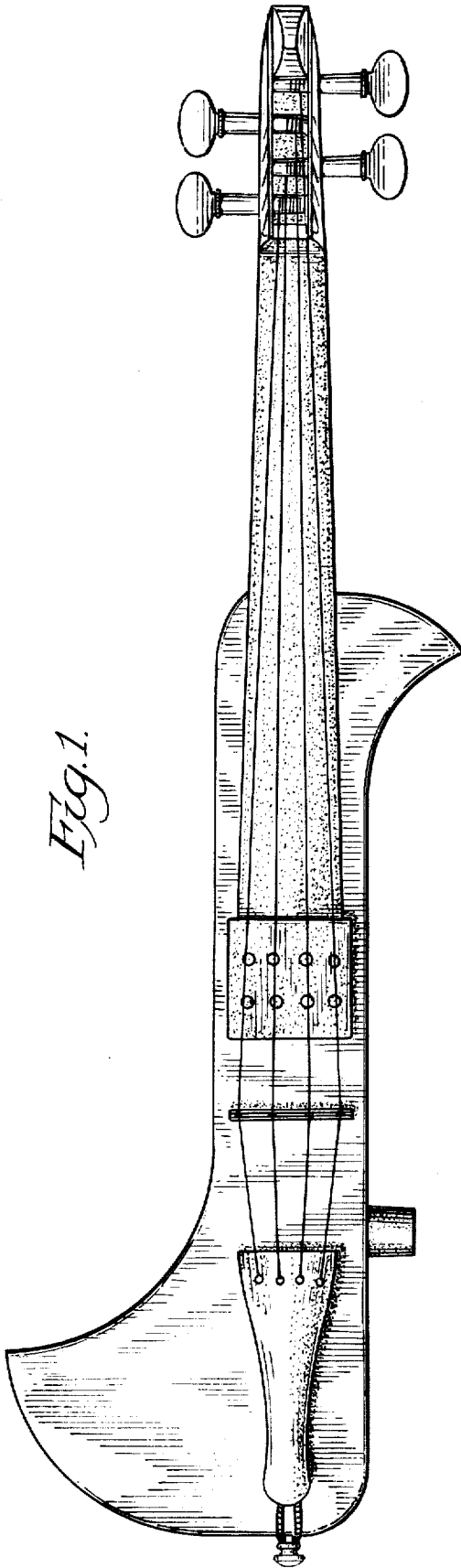
