The ornamental design for a serving spoon, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a serving spoon embodying my new design.

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a transverse sectional view thereof taken along the line 5—5 of FIG. 3.

FIG. 6 is a transverse sectional view thereof taken along the line 6—6 of FIG. 3.

FIG. 7 is a transverse sectional view thereof taken along the line 7—7 of FIG. 3.
