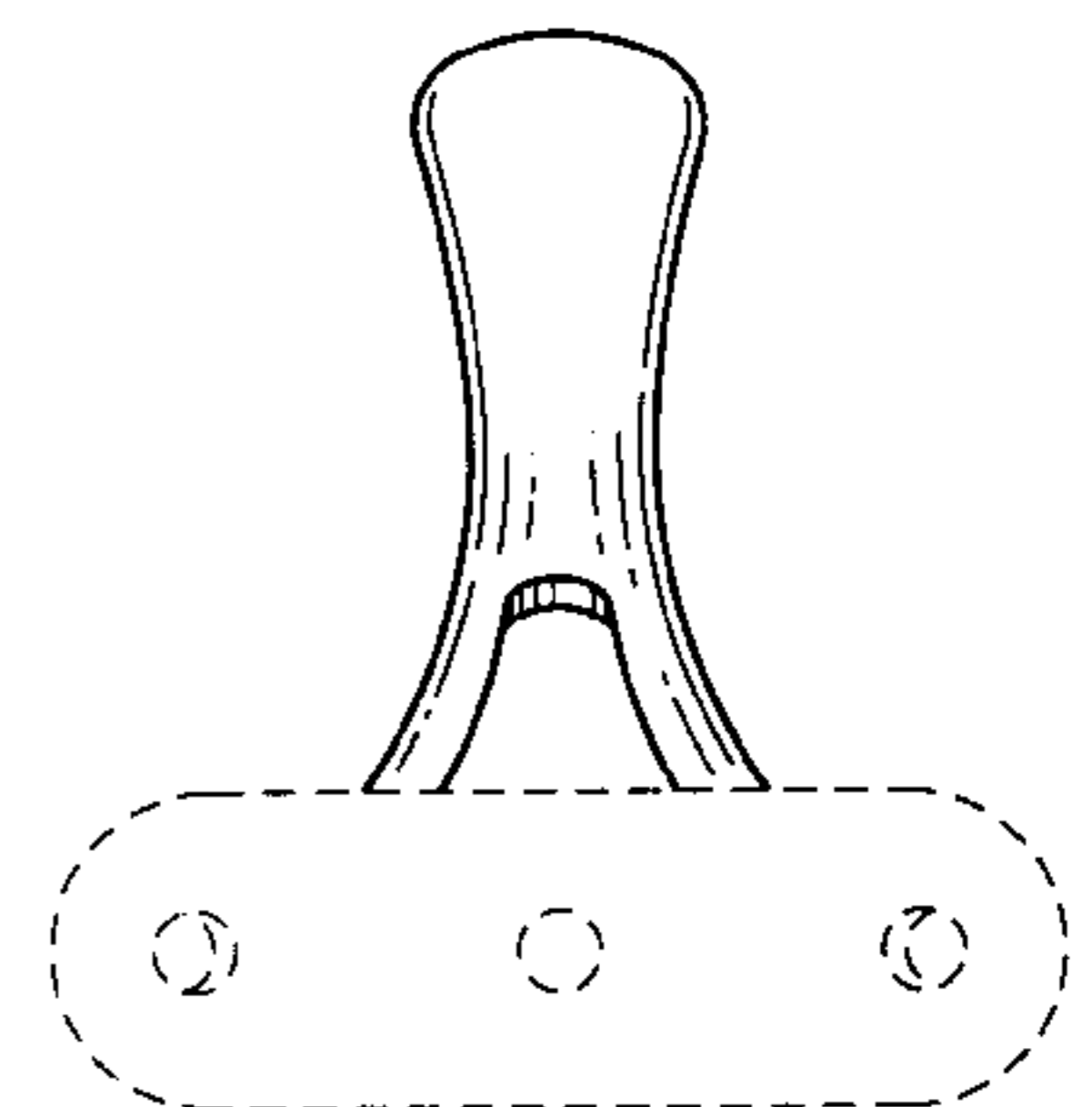
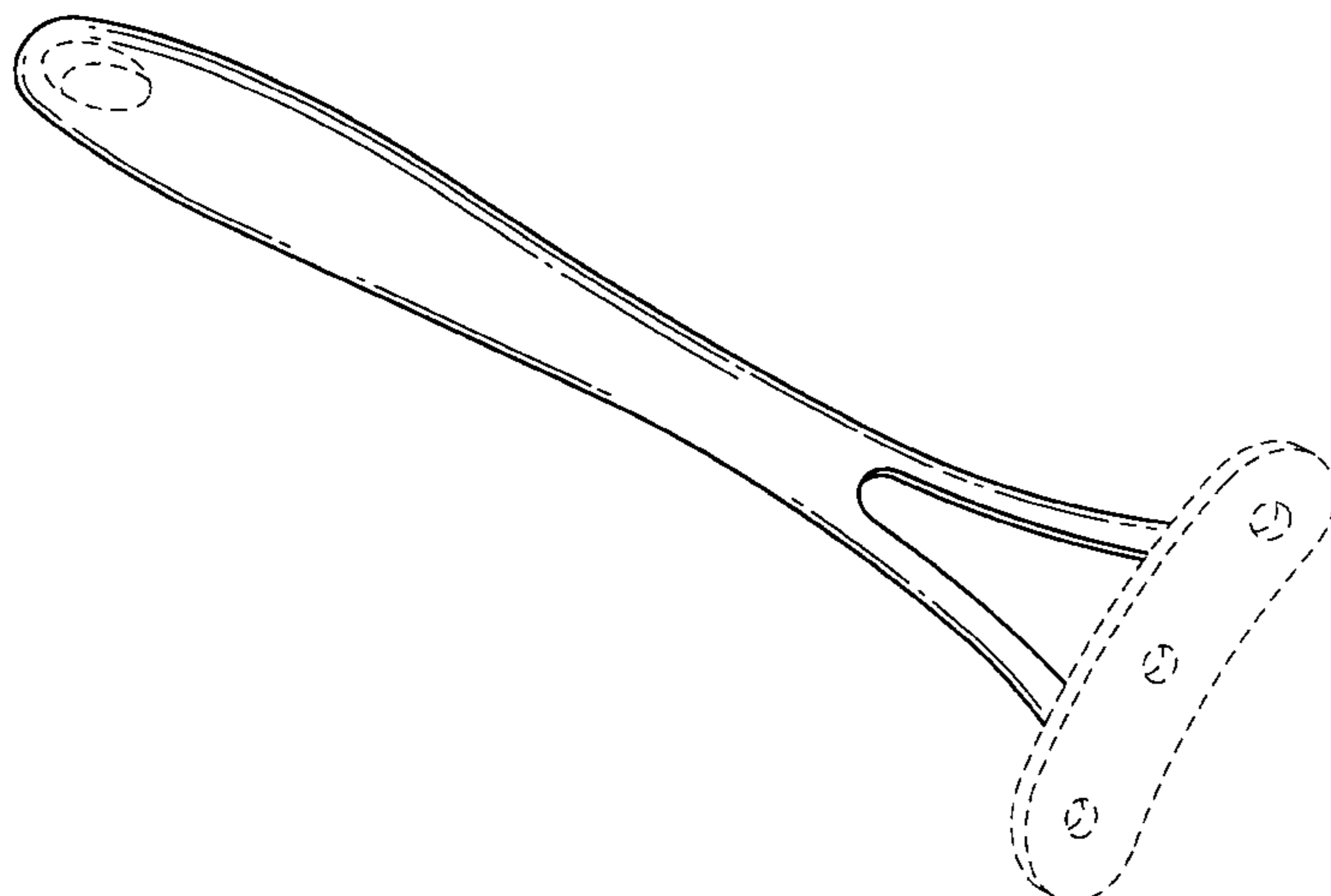

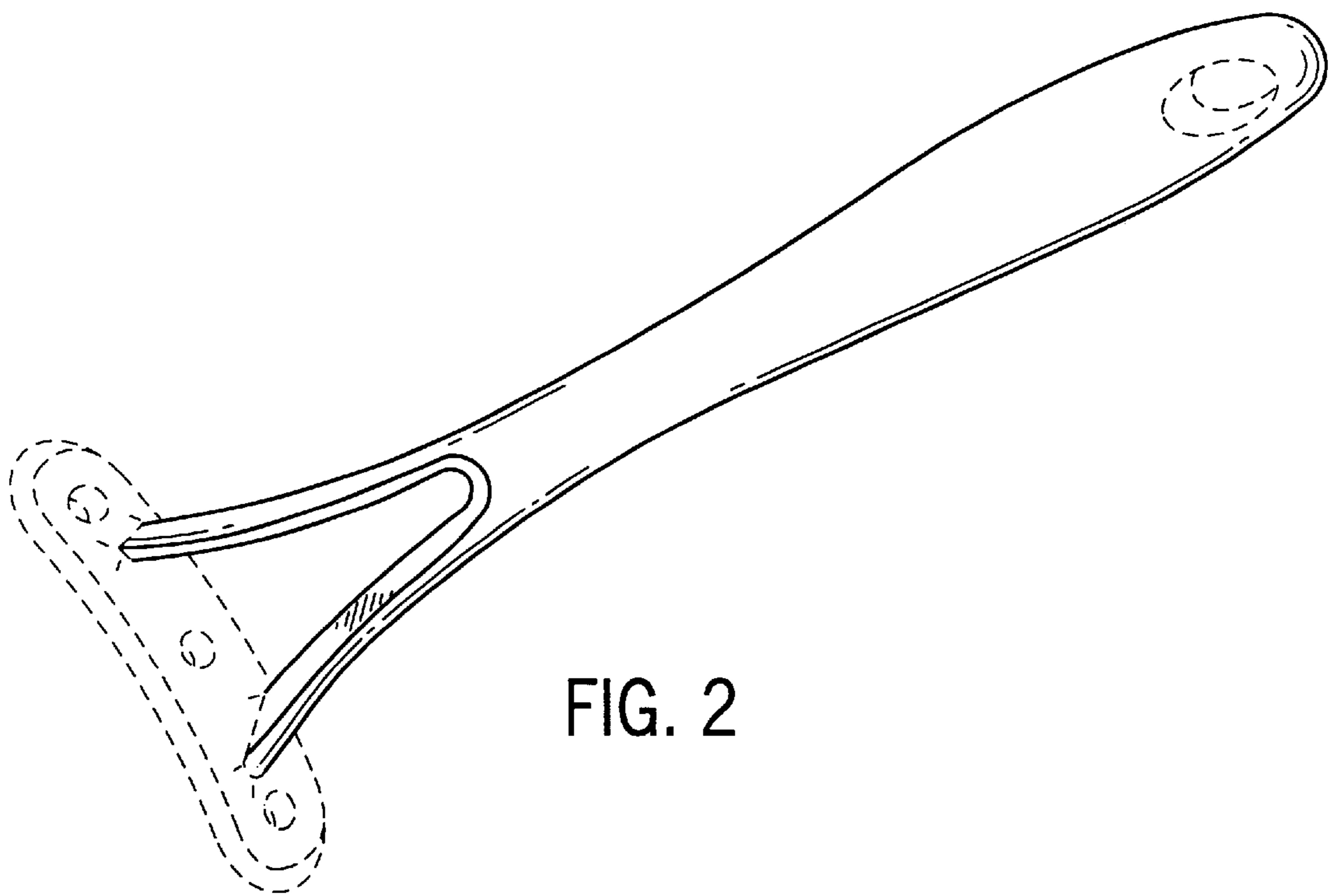
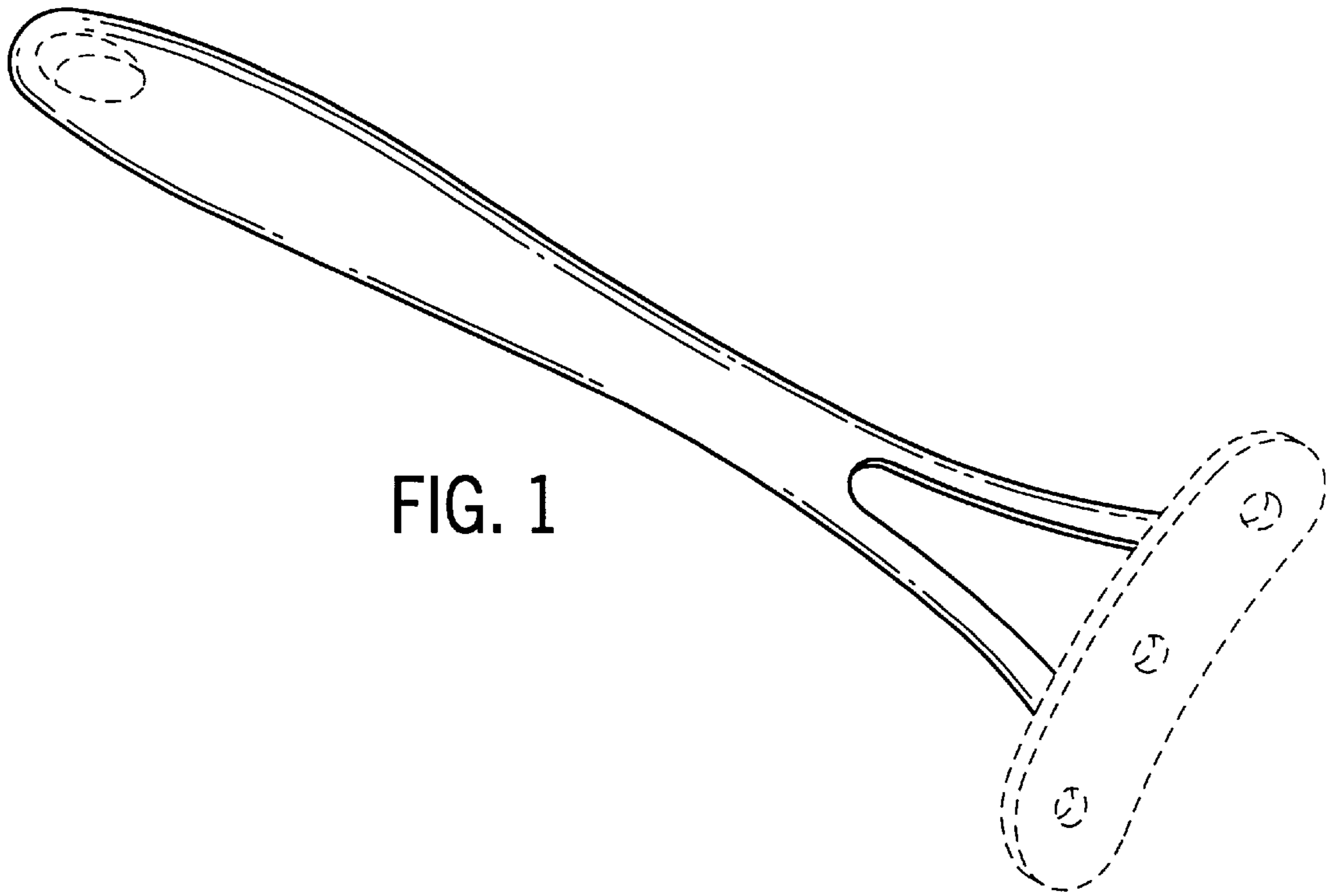
The ornamental design for the cookware handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a cookware handle showing a preferred embodiment of my design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view of the preferred embodiment of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the cookware handle of FIG. 3, the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side view of the cookware handle of FIG. 3;
FIG. 6 is a left side view of the cookware handle of FIG. 3; and,
FIG. 7 is the bottom plan view of the cookware handle of the preferred embodiment of FIG. 1.
The broken line showings in FIGS. 1-7 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

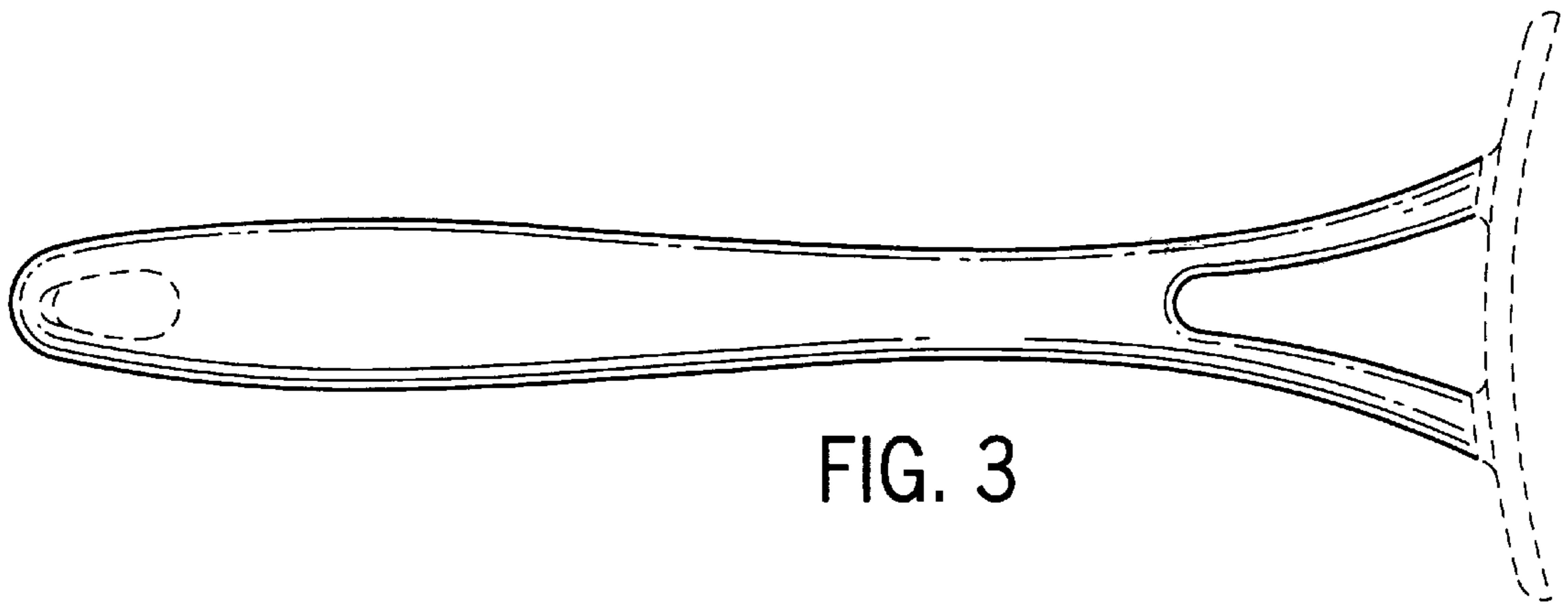

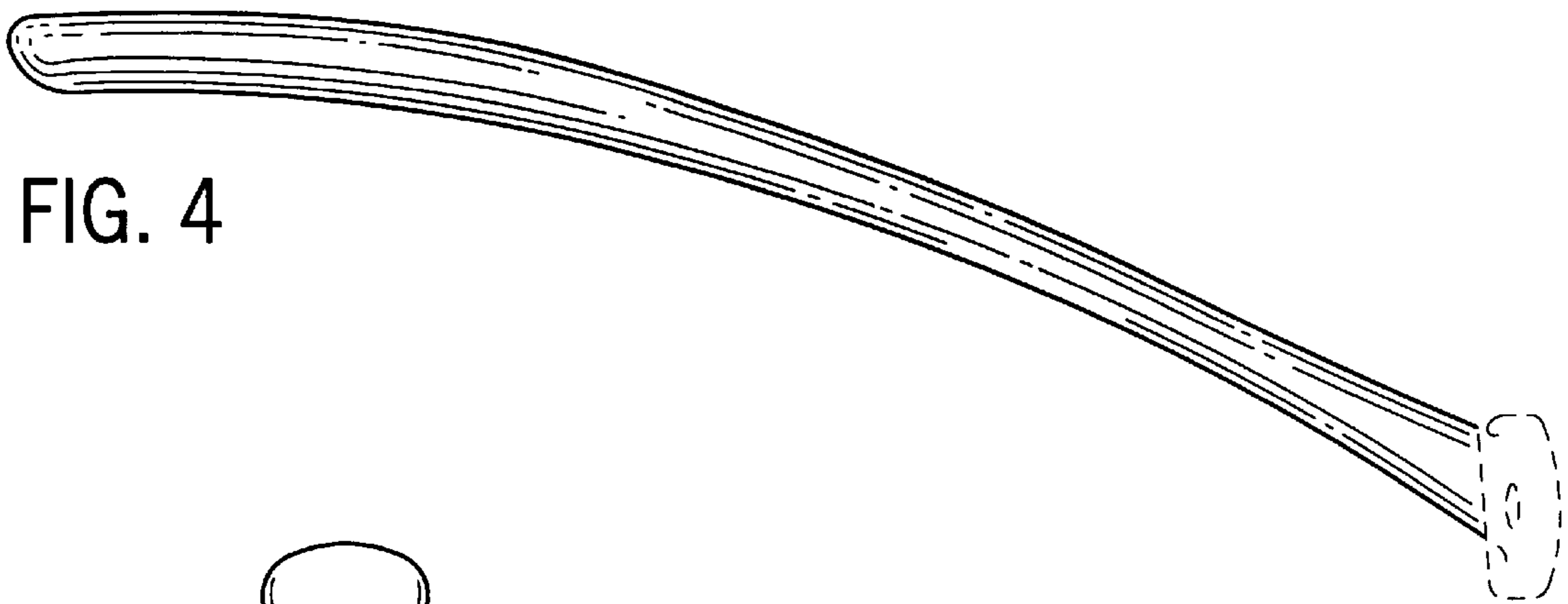

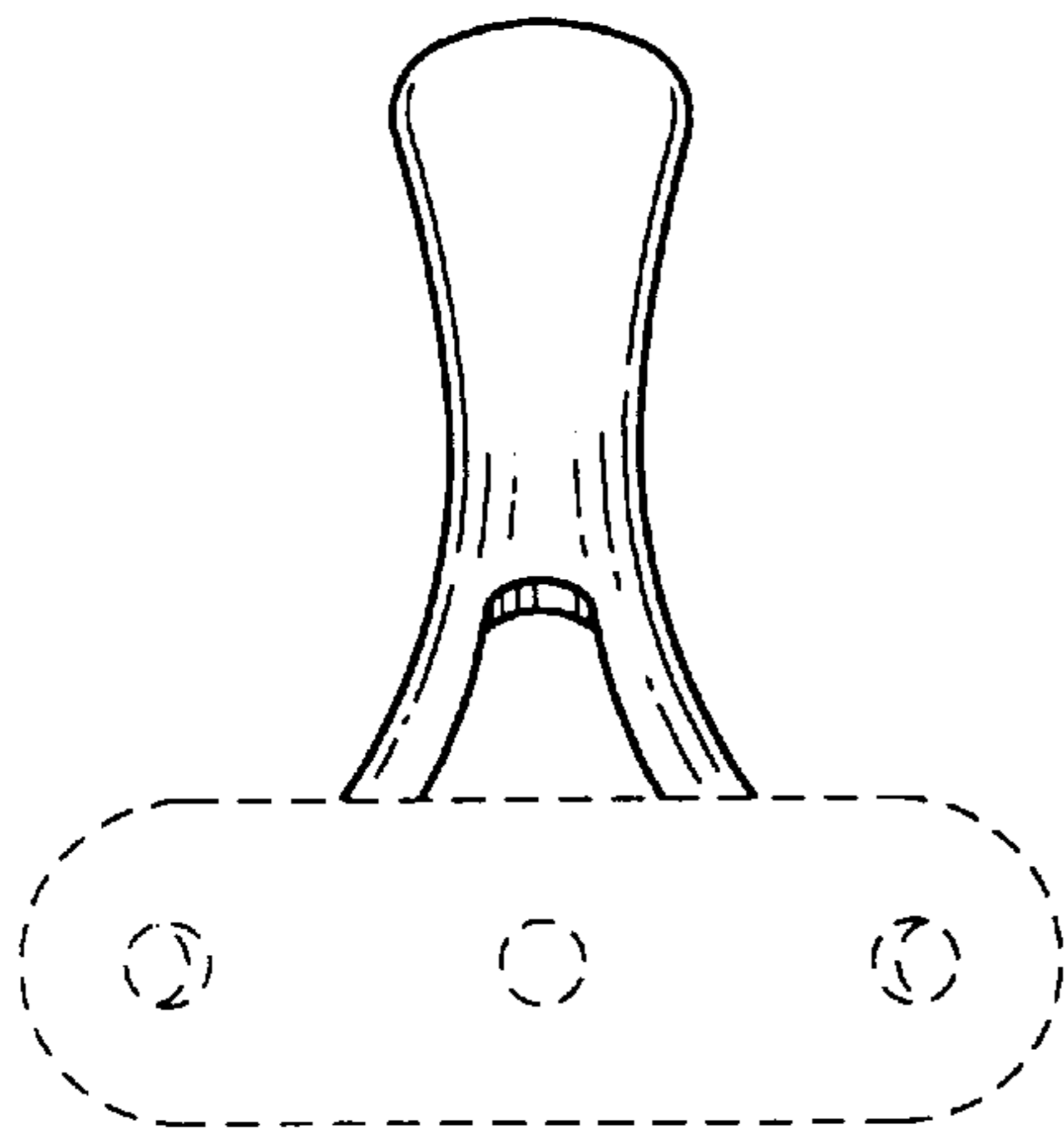

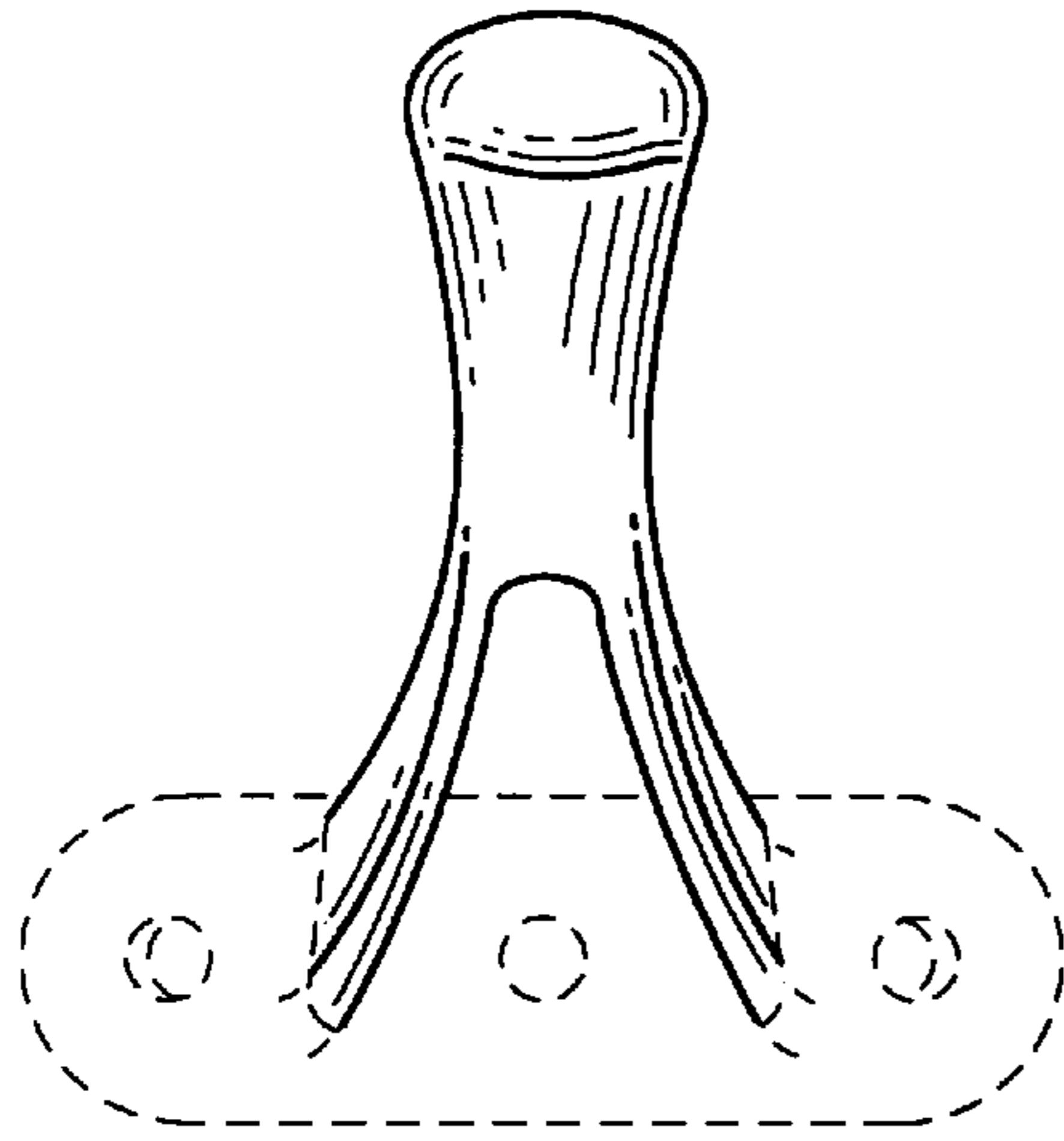

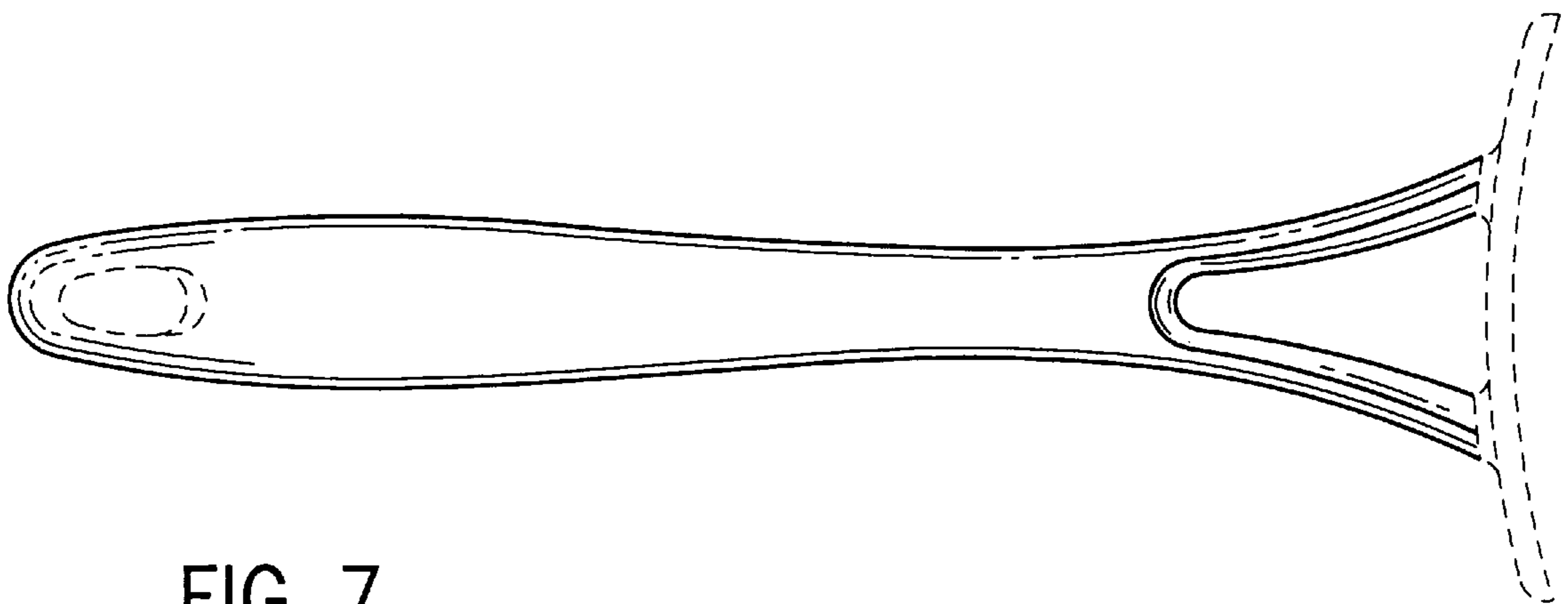
