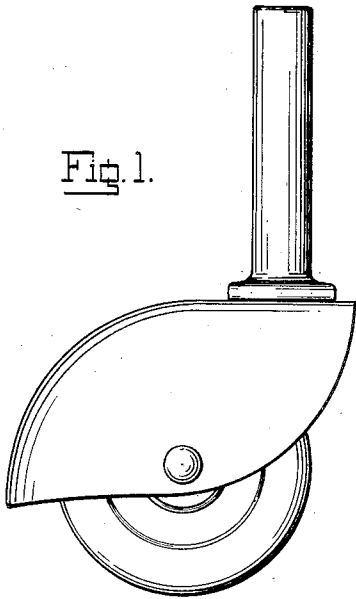

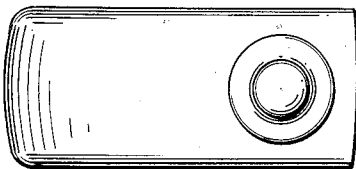
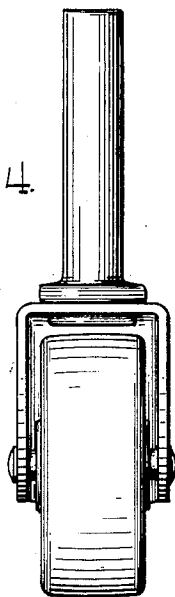

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Walter F. Herold, a citizen of the United States, residing at Bridgeport, in the county of Fairfield and State of Connecticut, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Caster, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a side elevation of a caster, showing my new design, the dominant feature of which is the streamlined profile of the caster horn.

Fig. 2 is a front elevation thereof.

Fig. 3 is a top plan view.

Fig. 4 is a rear elevation.

I claim:—

The ornamental design for a caster, as shown and described.
