[57] CLAIM

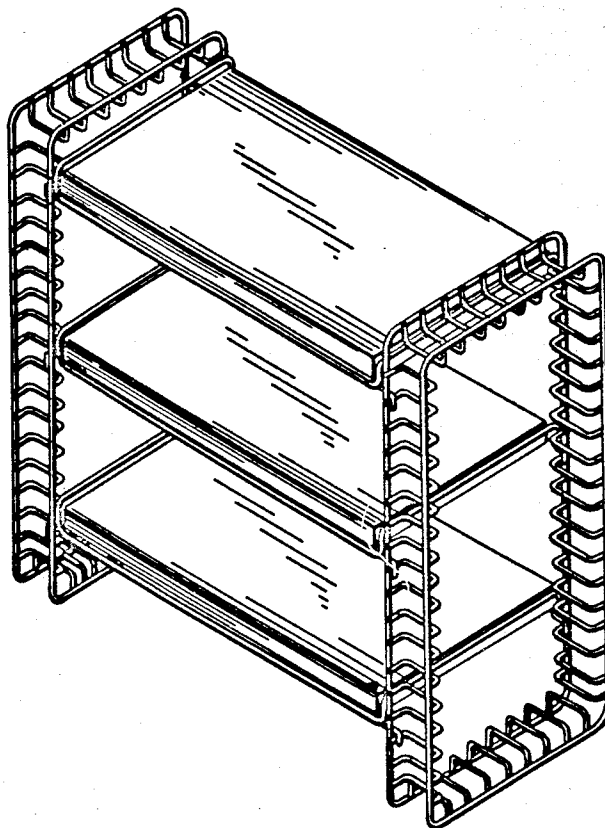
The ornamental design for a shelf unit, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shelf unit showing my new design, the rear perspective view being identical thereto;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view, the opposite side not shown being identical thereto.



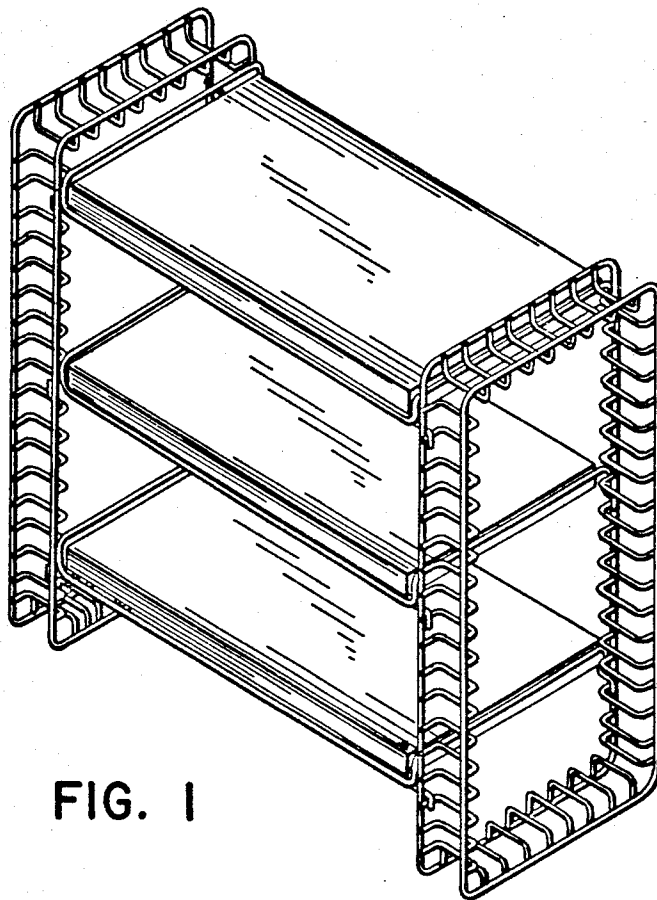

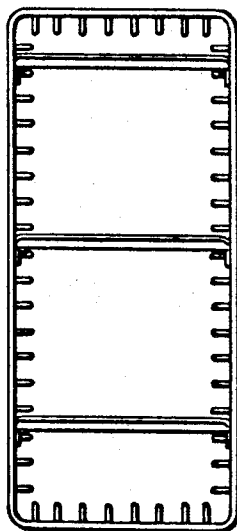

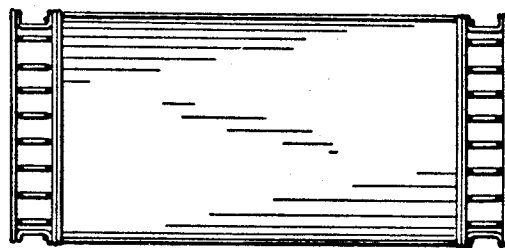
