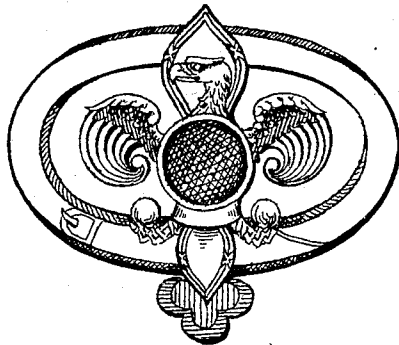

DESIGN FOR A BUCKLE-PLATE OR SIMILAR ARTICLE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 36,725, dated January 5, 1904.

Application filed November 27, 1903. Serial No. 182,913. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:
