

## (54) Title: METHOD FOR MANUFACTURING COMPOSITE SHAFTS

#### (57) Abstract

The invention pertains to a method for manufacturing a composite shaft. The method includes the steps of: providing an impregnated fibrous material (280); wrapping the impregnated fibrous material (280) around a shaped pressurizable bladder (260); placing the assembly of the bladder (260) and the fibrous material (280) into the female tooling (204); pressurizing the bladder (260), thereby pressing the fibrous material (280) against the tooling (204); heating the tooling (204), thereby forming the fibrous material (280) into a hardened composite while maintaining pressure in the bladder (260); releasing the pressure in the bladder (260); and removing the bladder (260) from the interior of the hardened composite.
