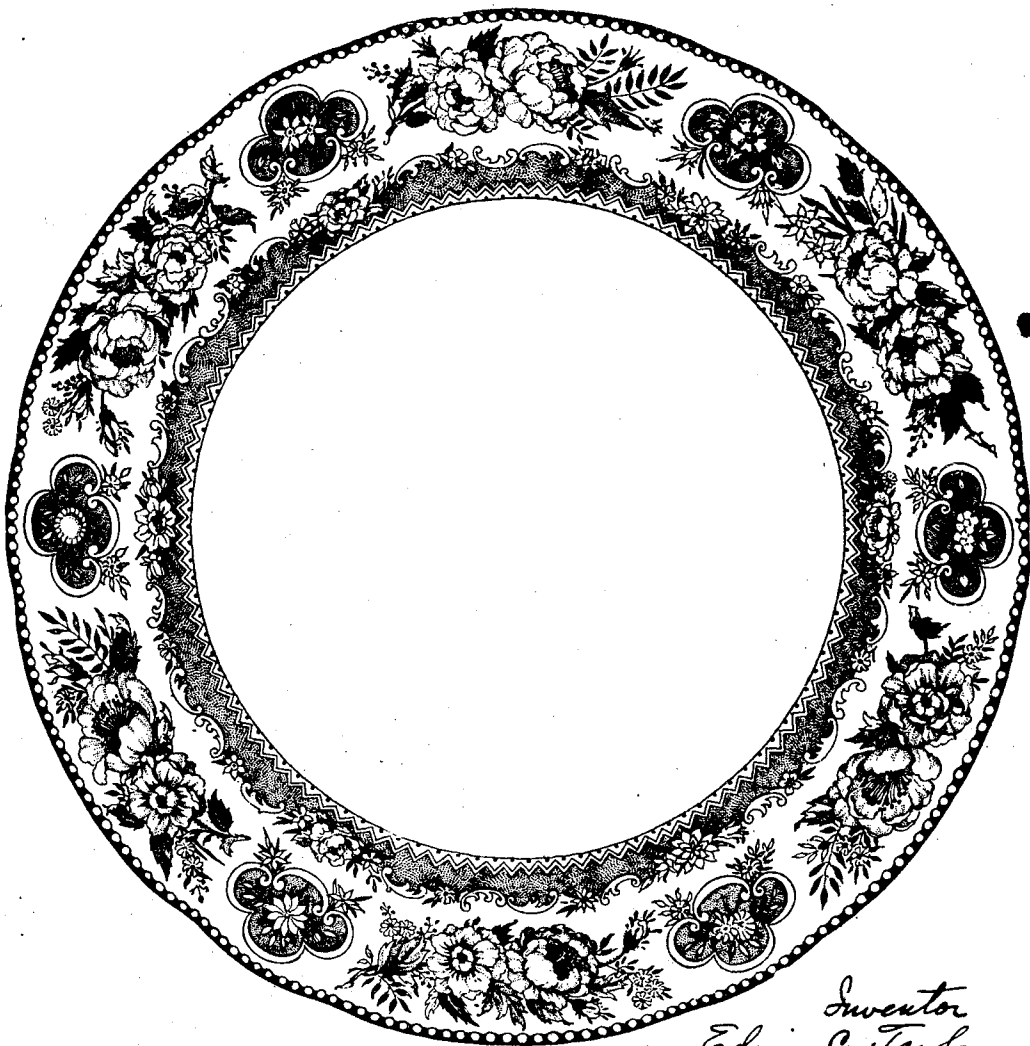

DESIGN FOR A PLATE

Application filed November 12, 1930. Serial No. 37,629. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, EDWIN C. TAYLOR, a citizen of the United States, residing at New Haven, in the county of New Haven and State of Connecticut, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Plate, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
