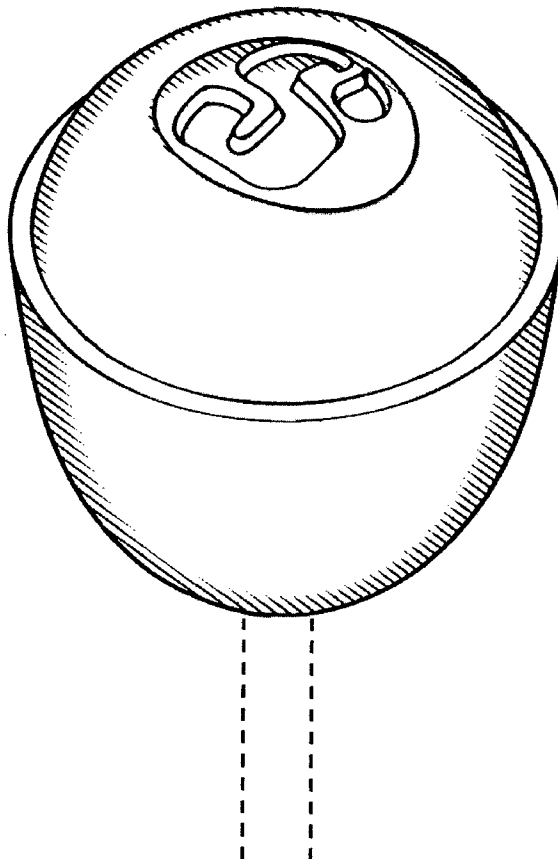
DESCRIPTION

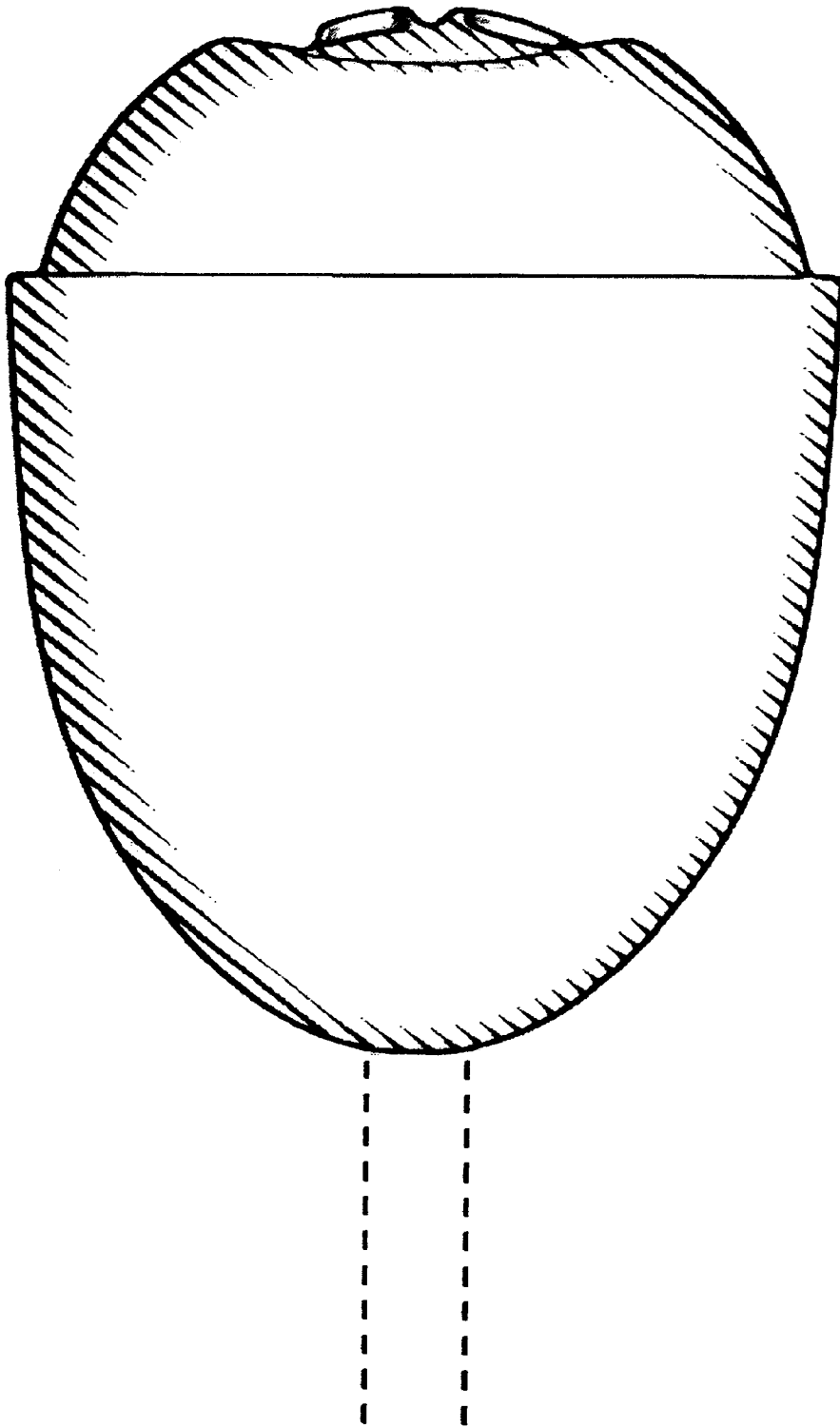

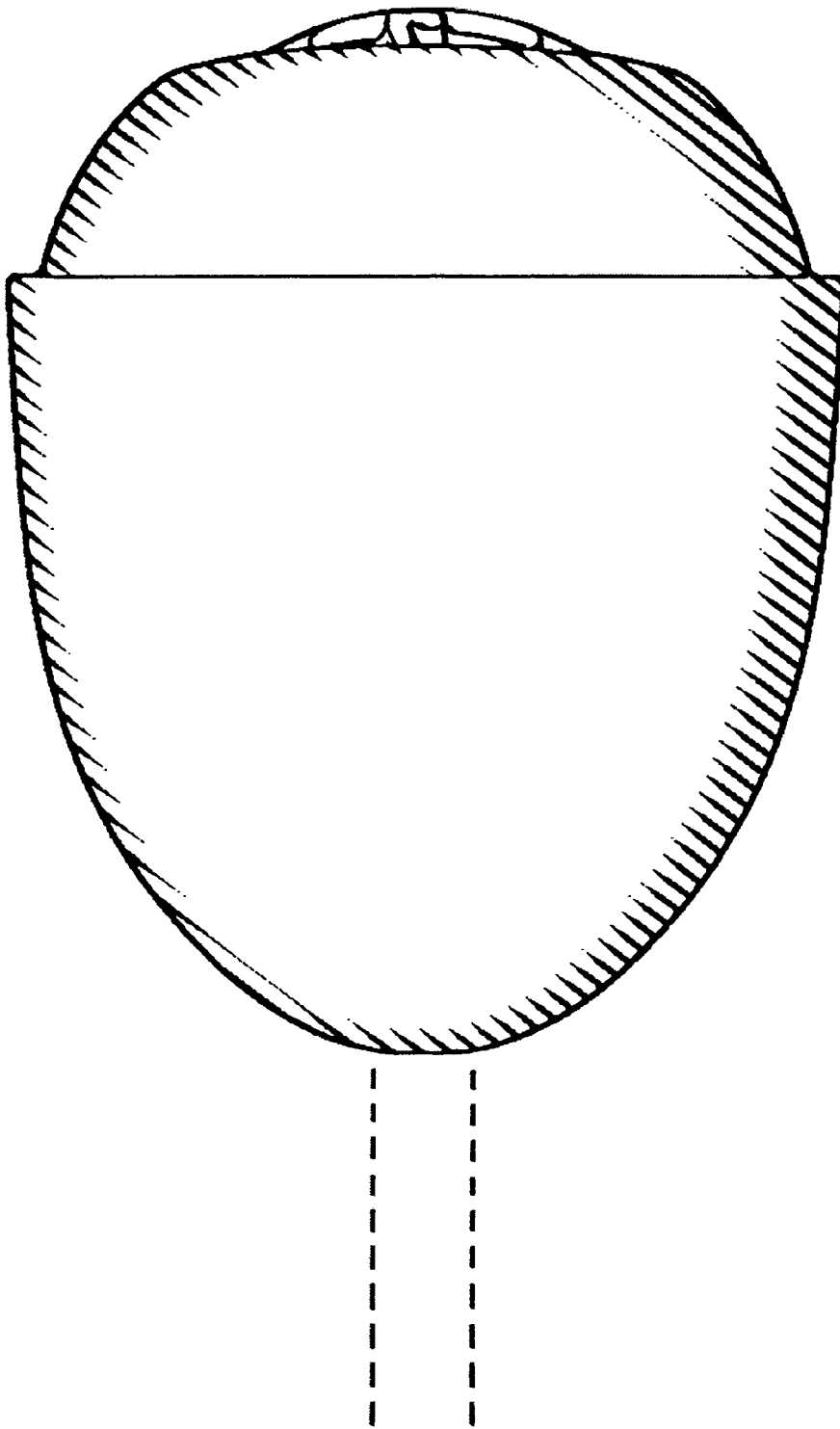

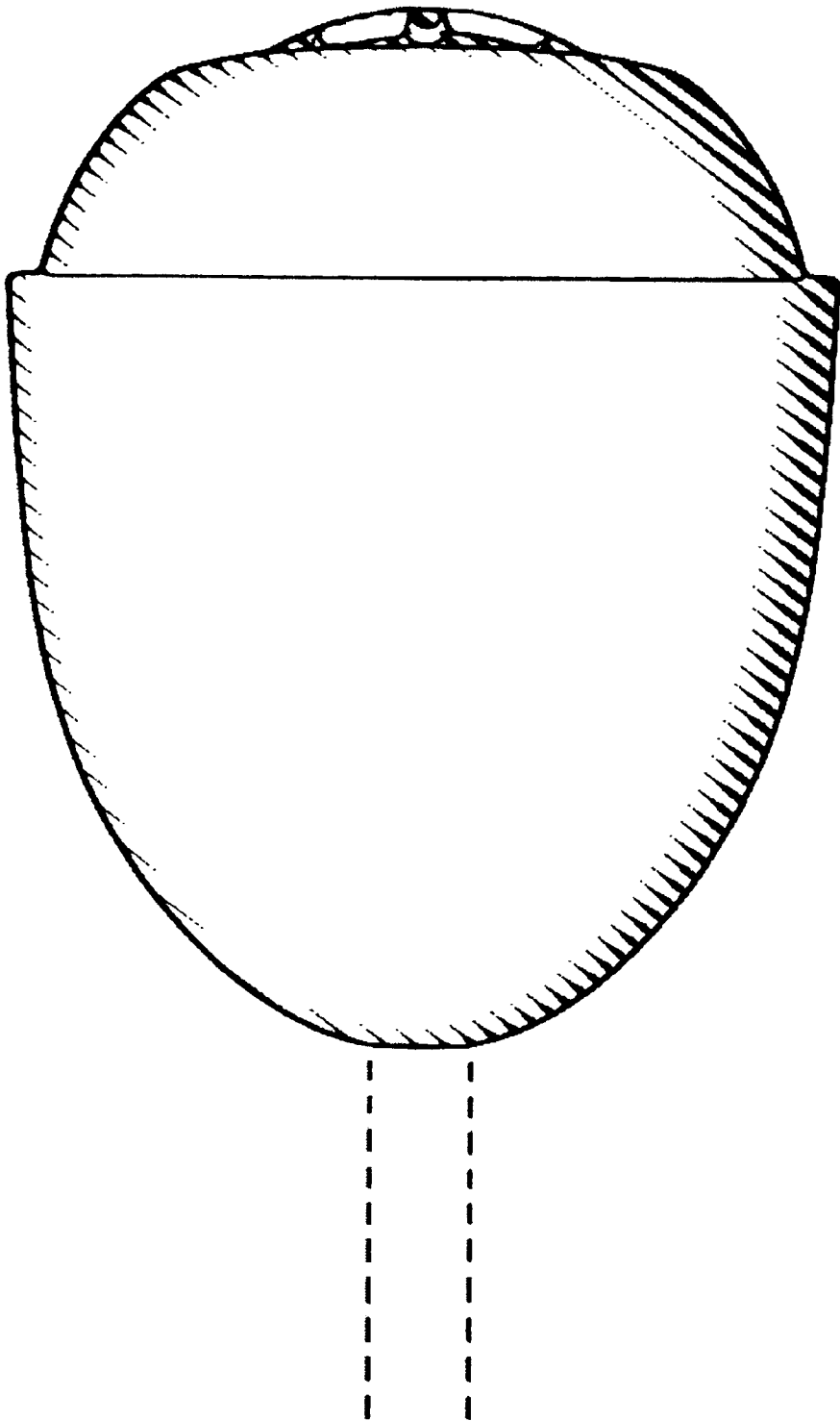

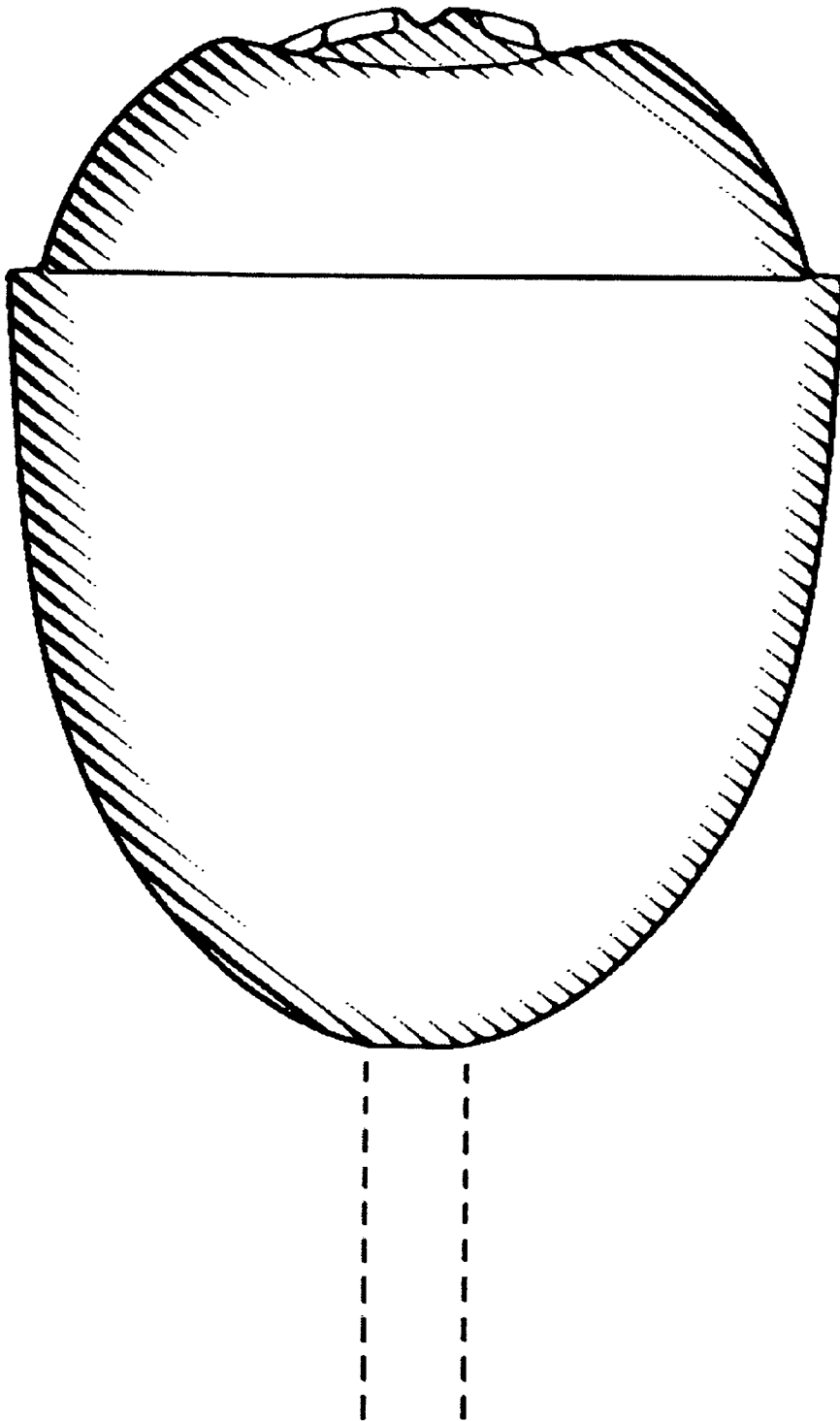

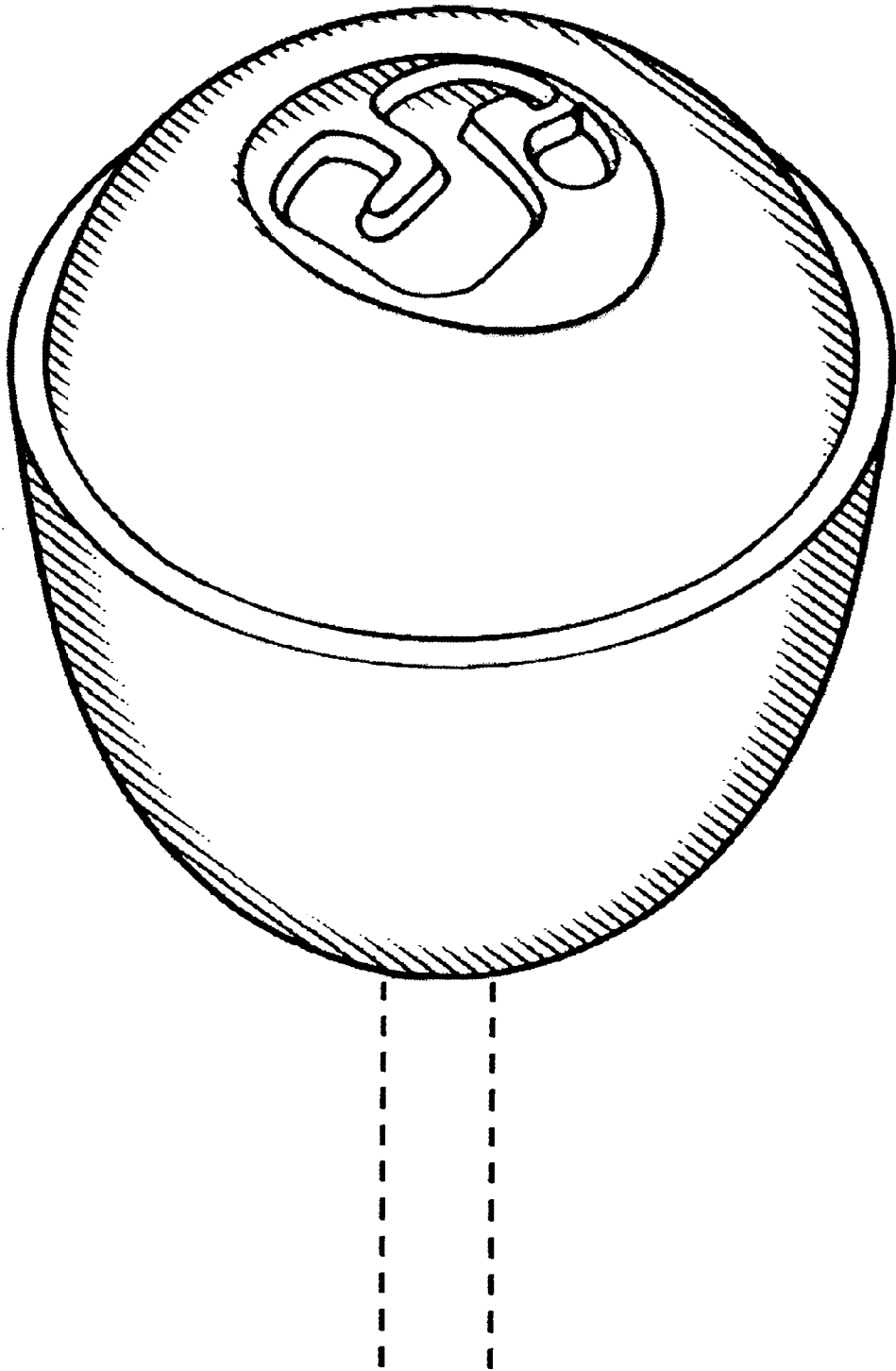

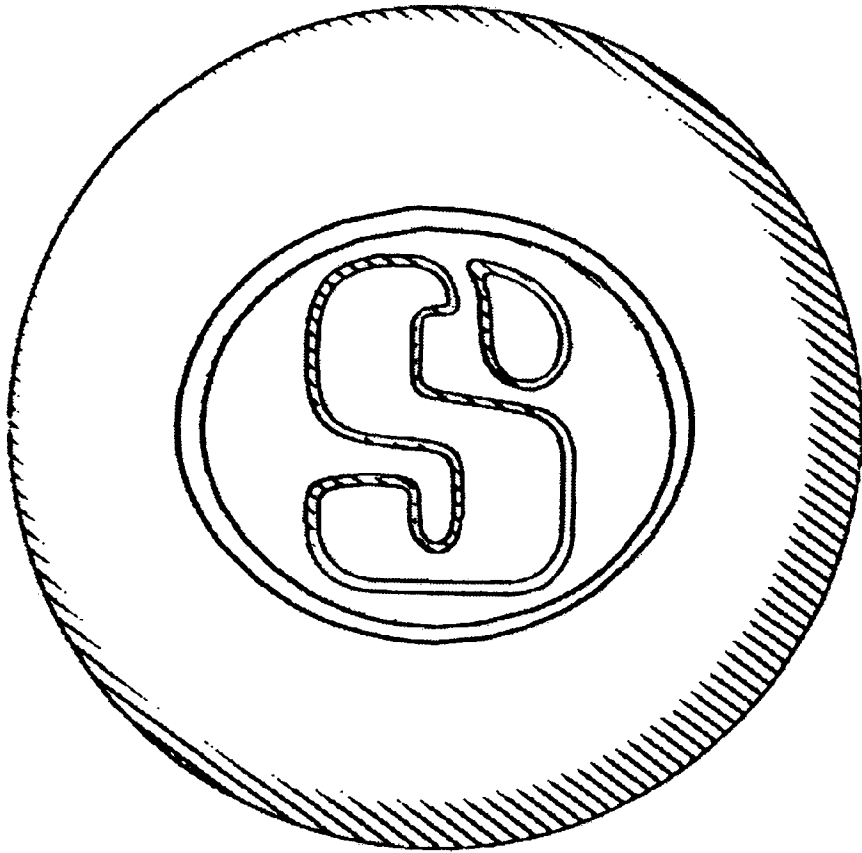

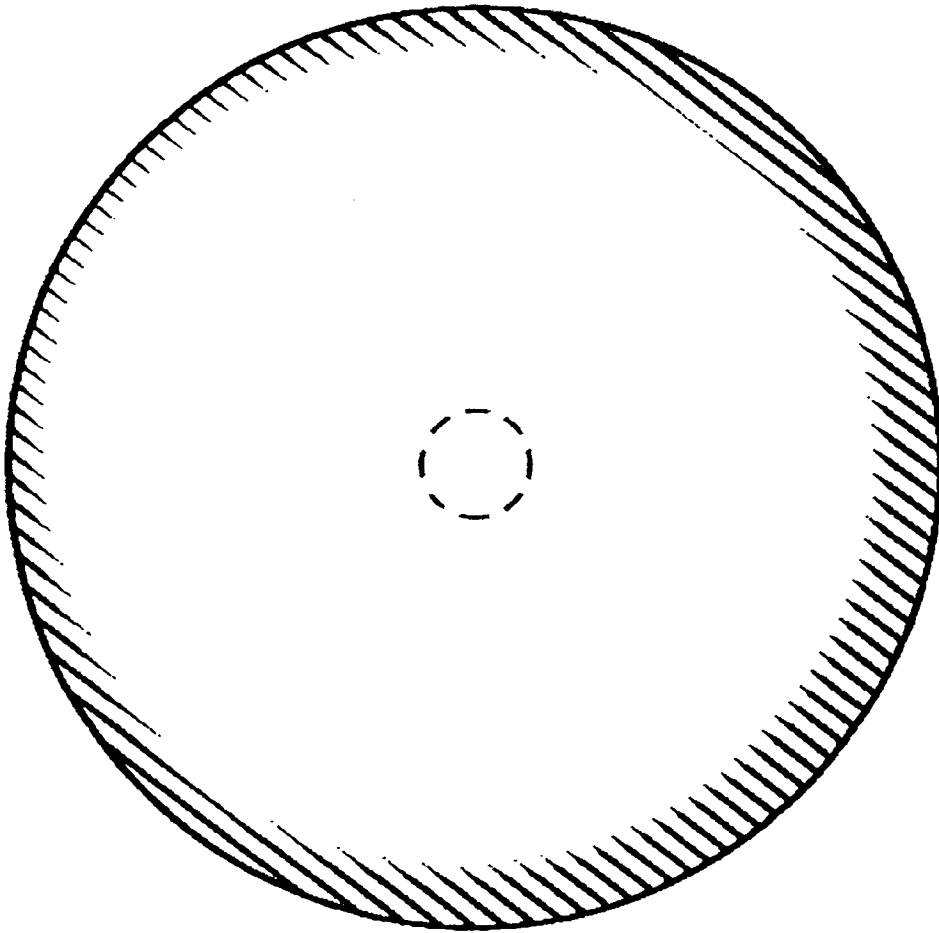
