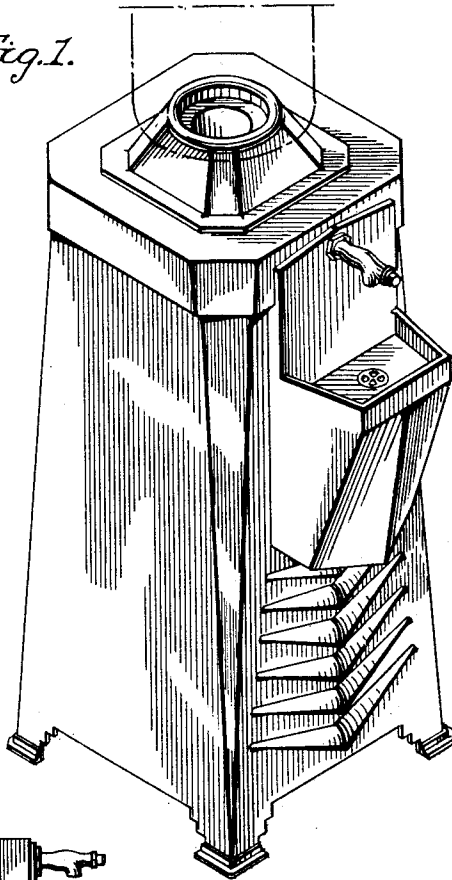

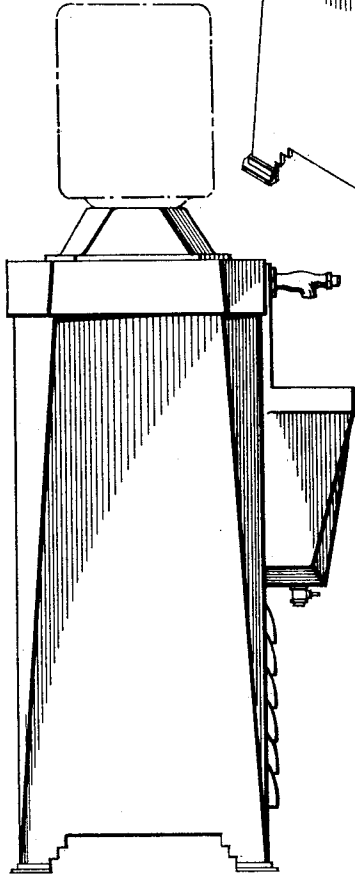
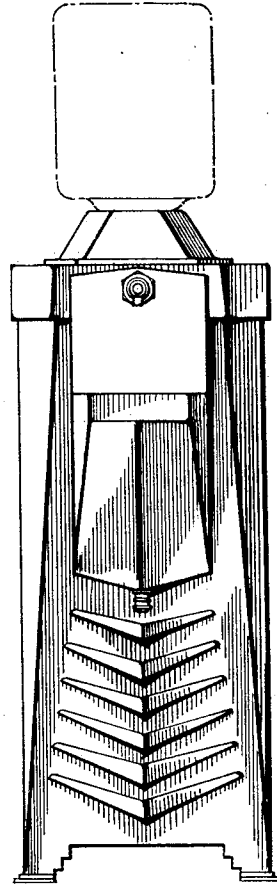

DESIGN FOR A BOTTLE-TYPE WATER COOLER

Application filed July 21, 1932. Serial No. 44,403. Term of patent 3½ years

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, STEPHEN J. BENN, a citizen of the United States, residing in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bottle-type Water Cooler, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which:—

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a bottle-type

water cooler embodying my design the upper portion of the bottle being shown only partially;

Fig. 2 is a side elevation thereof; and
Fig. 3 is a front elevation thereof.
