FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view of both embodiments of my invention.

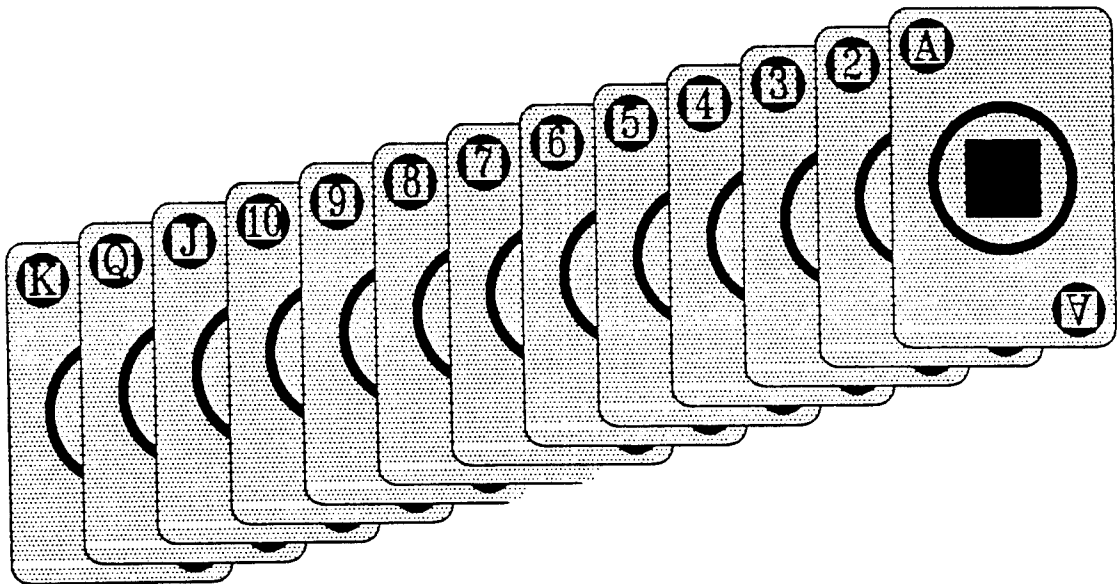

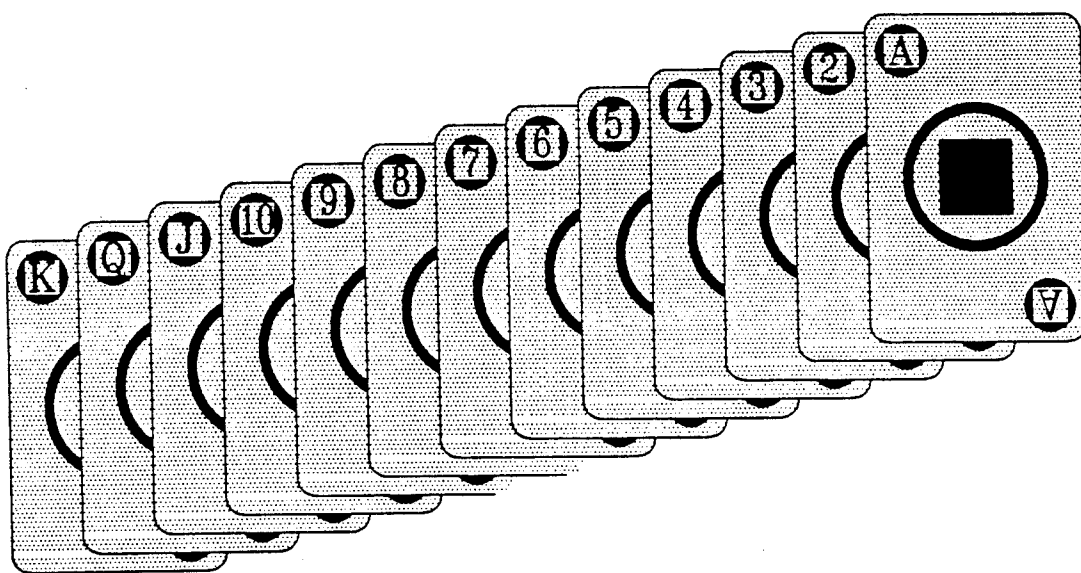

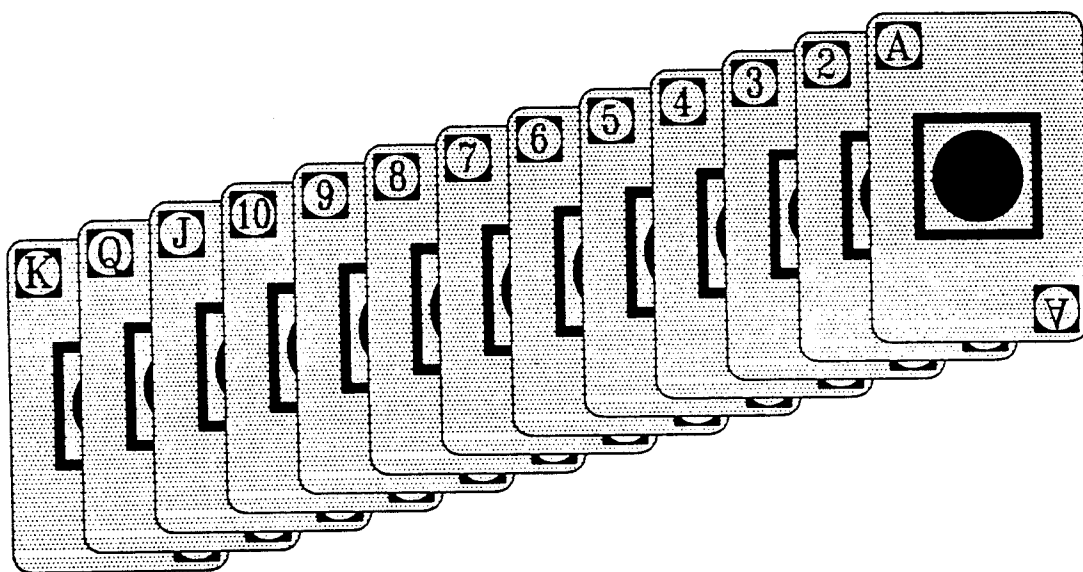
