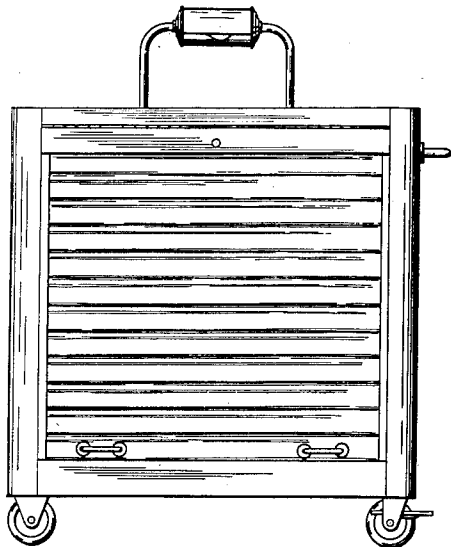

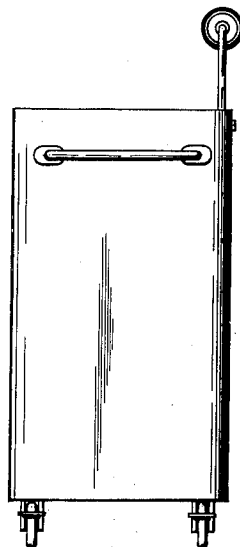

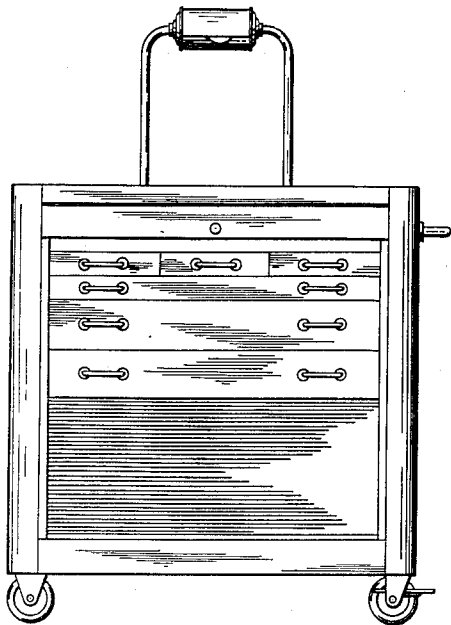

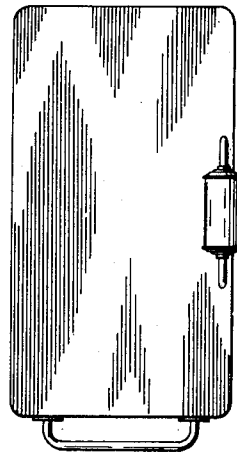

DESIGN FOR A TOOL CABINET

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Albert P. Siersma, a citizen of the United States and a resident of Chicago, county of Cook, and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Tool Cabinet, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Figure 1 is a front view in elevation of a tool cabinet showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a side view in elevation thereof.

Figure 3 is a front view in elevation of the tool cabinet shown in Figure 1 with the front flexible panel drawn up to enable access to the drawers and the lamp support is in raised position.

Figure 4 is a plan view thereof.

The rear panel of the tool cabinet is plain.
