

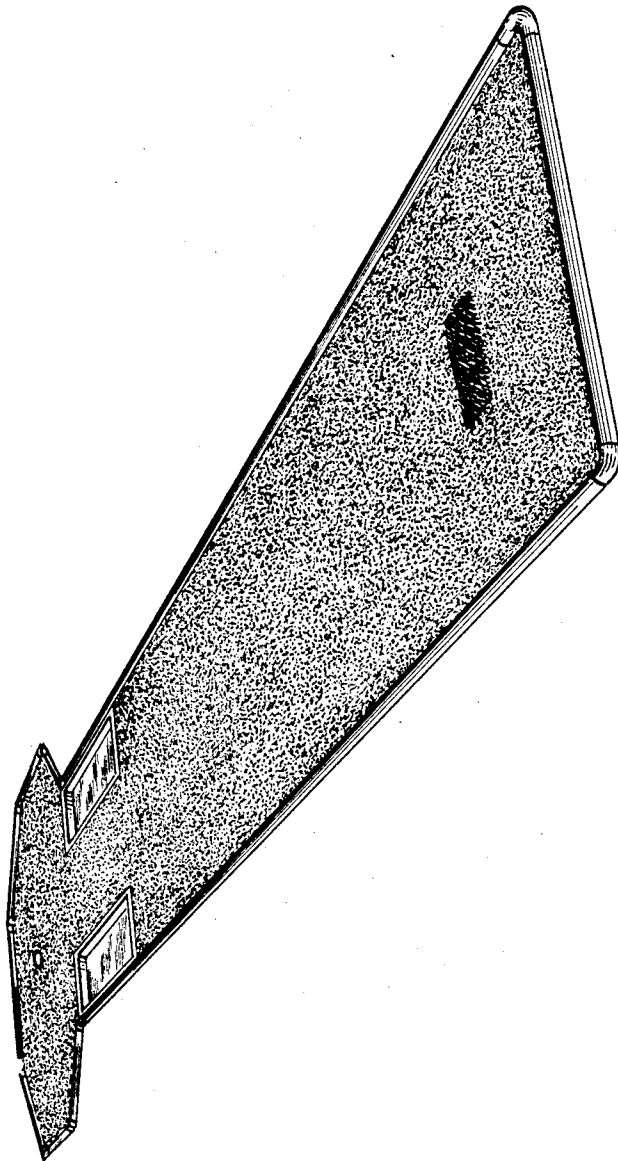

Application filed November 6, 1930. Serial No. 37,567. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:
