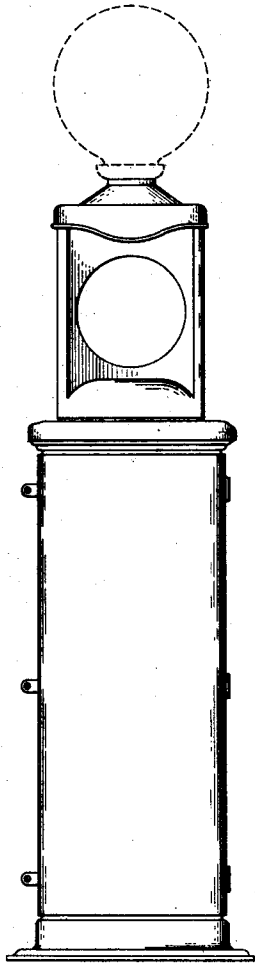
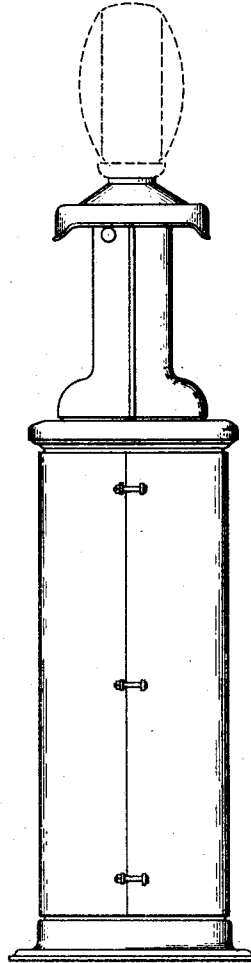

DESIGN FOR A CASING FOR AN OIL PUMP

To all whom it may concern:
