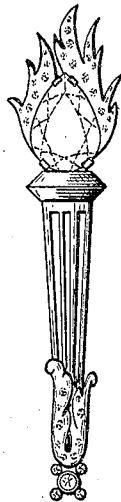

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, William B. Weinstock, a citizen of the United States, residing at Kew Garden Hills, Flushing, in the county of Queens and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Brooch or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a plan view of a brooch or similar article, showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a side view thereof.

The dominant feature of the design resides in the portions shown in full lines.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a brooch or similar article, substantially as shown and described.
