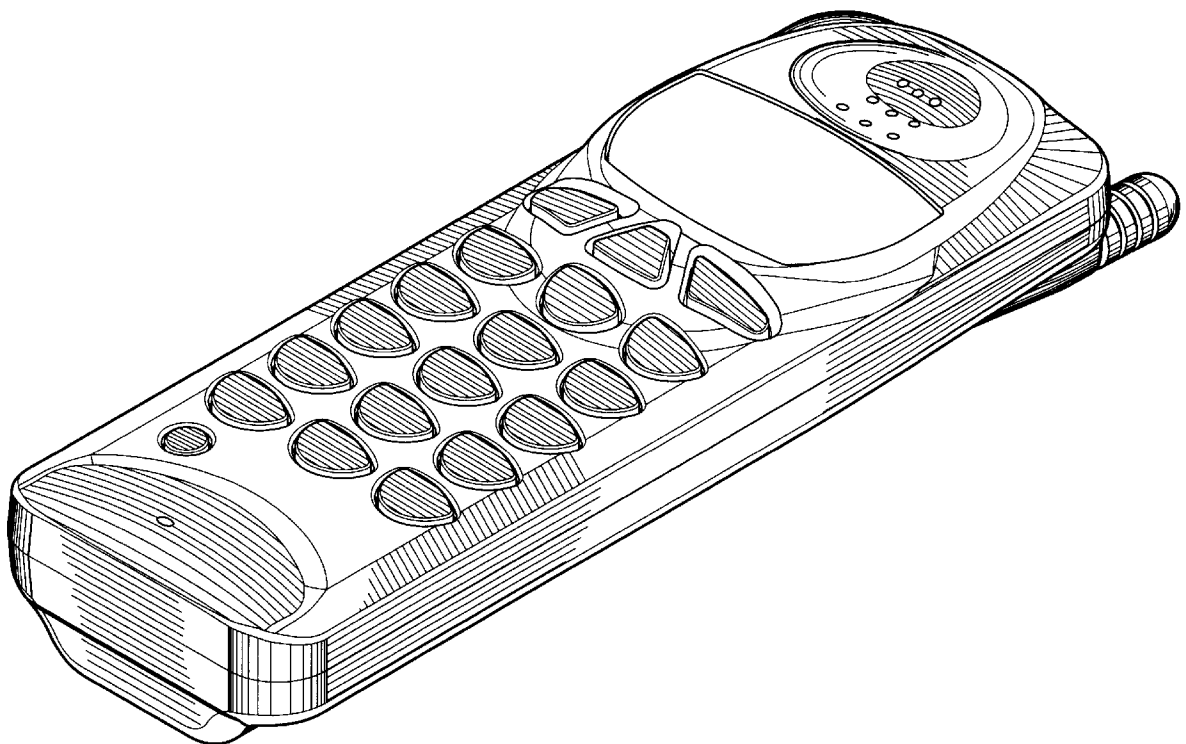

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the radiotelephone housing; FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the radiotelephone housing shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a left elevational view of the radiotelephone housing shown in FIG. 1; and, FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the radiotelephone housing shown in FIG. 1.

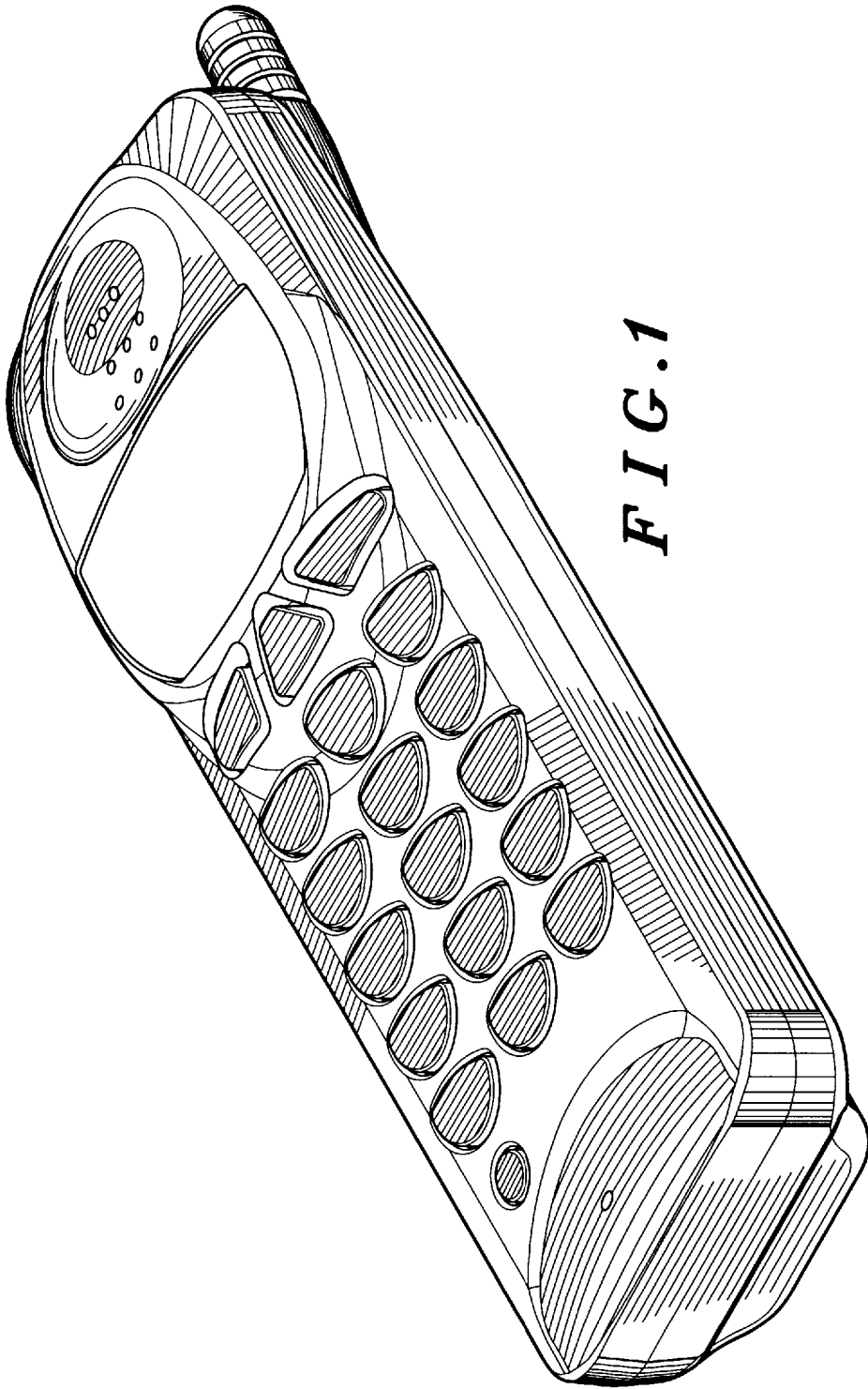

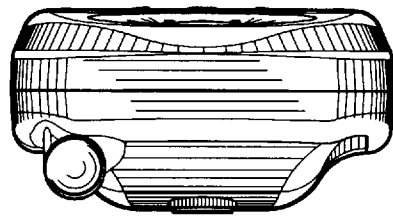

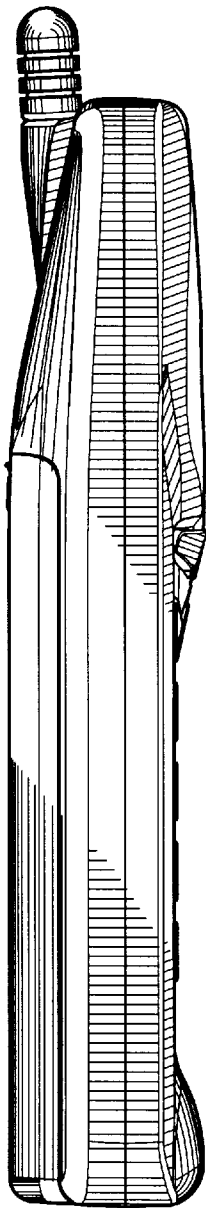

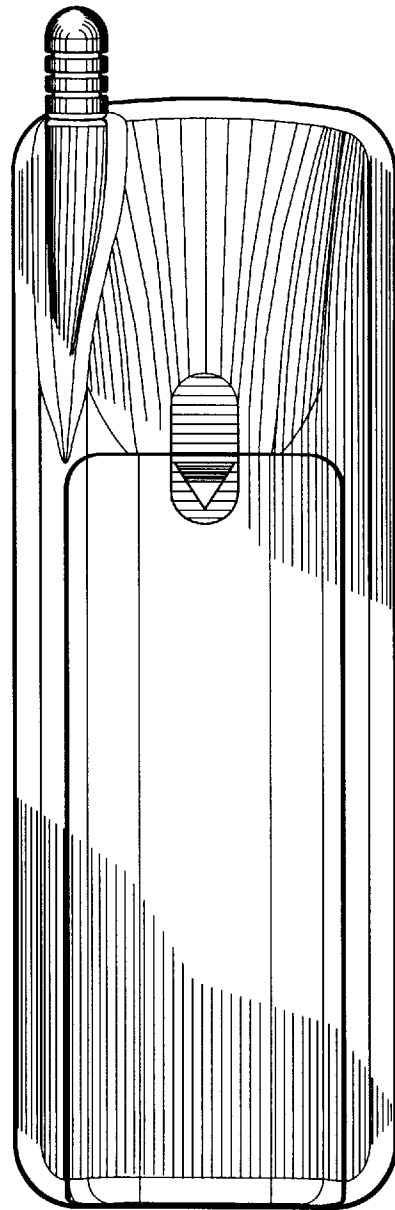
