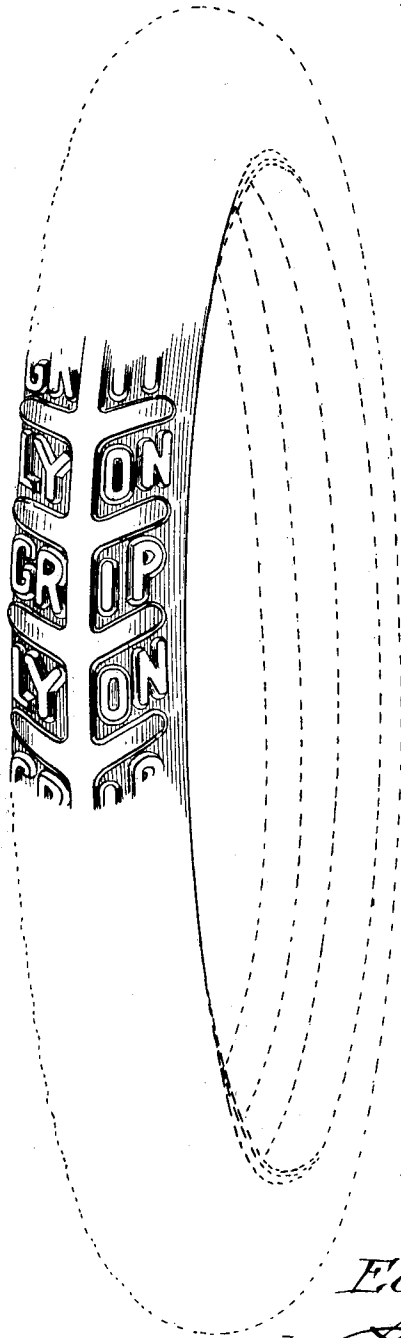

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, EDWARD F. LYON, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Tires, of which the following is the specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In said drawing, the figure is a perspective view of a tire, showing my new design applied thereto, a portion of the tire being illustrated in dotted lines.
