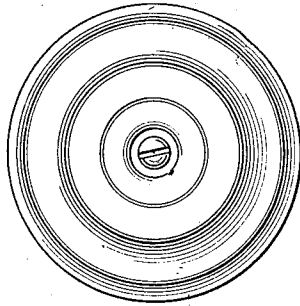
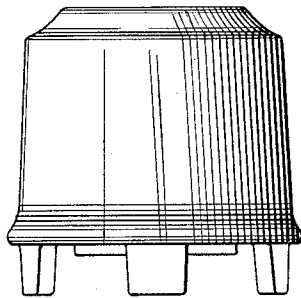

DESIGN FOR A CIGAR LIGHTER OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FRED C. TAMS, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Cigar Lighter or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof.
