**CLAIM** 

The ornamental design for a combined bottle and cap, substantially as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined bottle and cap showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an elevation view thereof, the opposite side being the same in appearance;

FIG. 3 is an elevation view thereof, looking from the right side of FIG. 2, the opposite side being the same in appearance;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the bottle;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is an elevation view of the bottle;

FIG. 8 is an elevation view thereof looking from the right side of FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is an elevation view of the cap; and

FIG. 10 is an elevation view thereof looking from the right side of FIG. 9.
