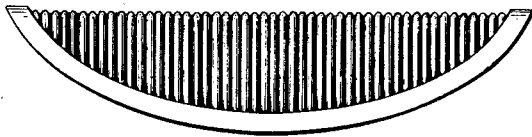

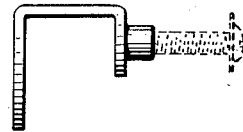

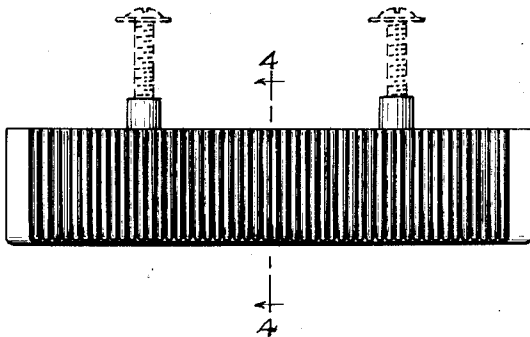
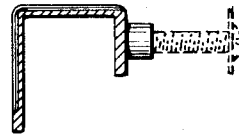

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Raymond H. Martin, a citizen of the United States, residing at Bridgeport, in the county of Fairfield, and State of Connecticut, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Drawer Pull, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a front elevation of a drawer pull, showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a top plan view.

Fig. 3 is an end elevation; and

Fig. 4 is a vertical sectional view, along the line 4—4 of Fig. 2.

I claim:—

The ornamental design for a drawer pull, as shown.
