



DESIGN FOR A GARMENT HANGER

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Jesse Hoyt Johnson, a citizen of the United States, residing at Denver, in the county of Denver and State of Colorado, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Garment Hanger, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a garment hanger, showing my new design; and

Fig. 2 is a vertical sectional view thereof, taken along the line 2—2, Fig. 1 and in the direction of the arrows.
