

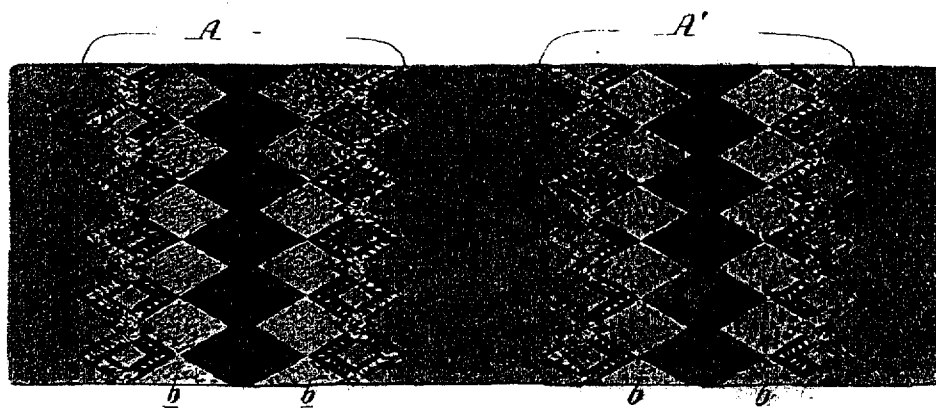

DESIGN FOR A STOCKING-FABRIC PATTERN.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Be it known that I, THOMAS DOLAN, of the city and county of Philadelphia, State of Pennsylvania, have invented or produced a new and original Design for a Stocking-Fabric; and I do hereby declare that the accompanying drawing, and the following explanation thereof, form a full, clear, and exact description of the said design.

The figure in the accompanying drawing represents a portion of the stocking-fabric, which has two stripes, A and A', each stripe consisting of a central figure, *a*, with serrated edges; and on each side of this central figure is a row of diamond-shaped spots, *b*, and on the outside of each of these rows are the zigzag ribs *d* and *e*, these several elements being arranged, in respect to each other, so as to produce the pattern clearly illustrated in the drawing.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim—

The design for a stocking-fabric, substantially as described, and represented in and by the accompanying drawing.
