The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a chair according to the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a front-elevational view of the chair of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the chair of FIGS. 1 and 2;

FIG. 4 is a side-elevational view of the chair of FIGS. 1–3, the other side view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the chair of FIGS. 1–4;

FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the chair of FIGS. 1-5;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of a chair according to the present invention;

FIG. 8 is a front-elevational view of the chair of FIG. 7;


FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view of the chair of FIGS. 7 and 8;

FIG. 10 is a side-elevational view of the chair of FIGS. 7–9, the other side view being a mirror image thereof;











