DESCRIPTION

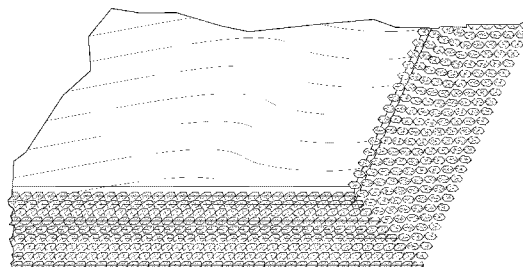
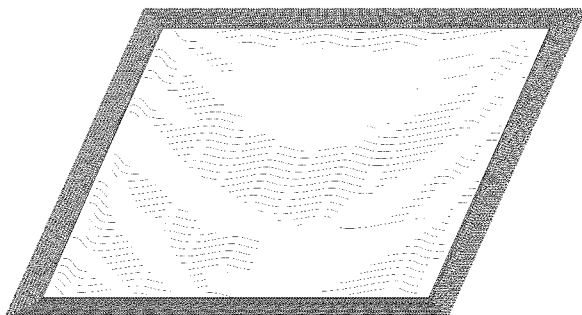
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lap scarf, showing my new design;

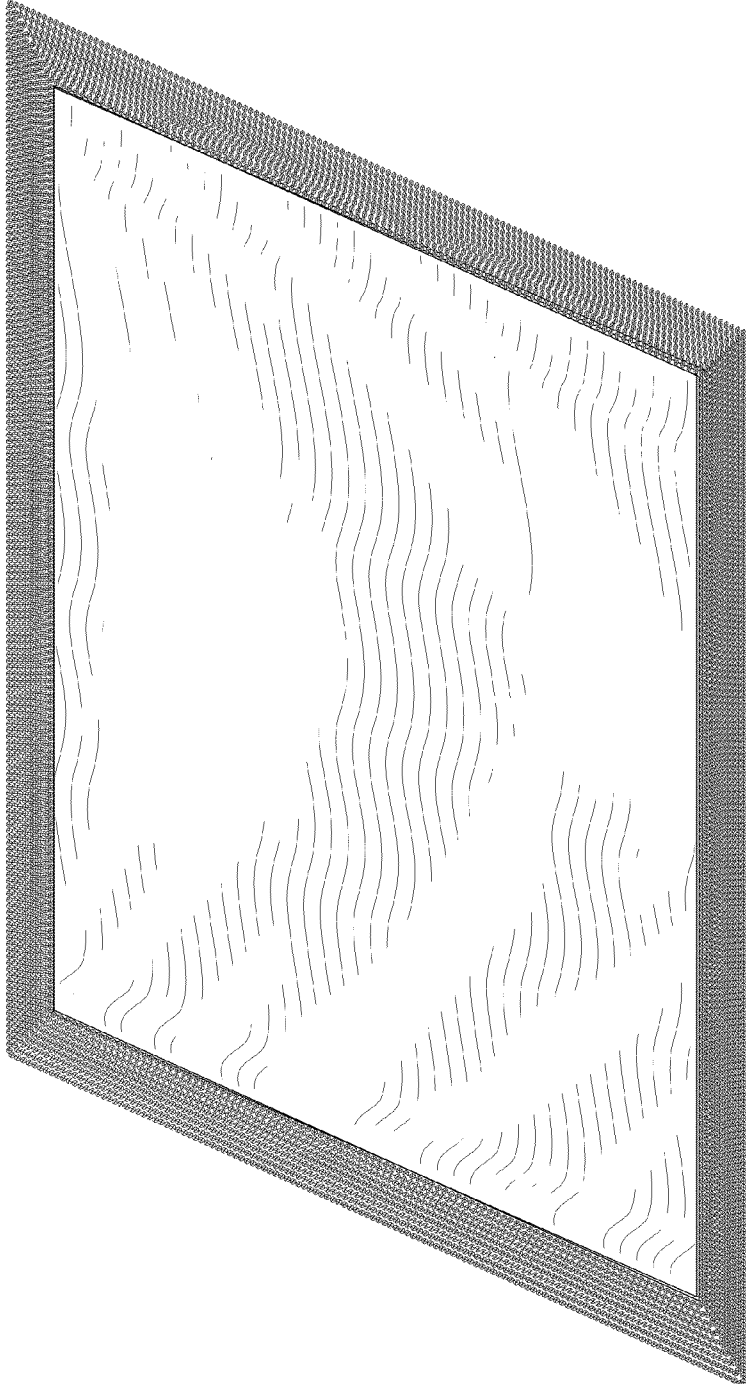

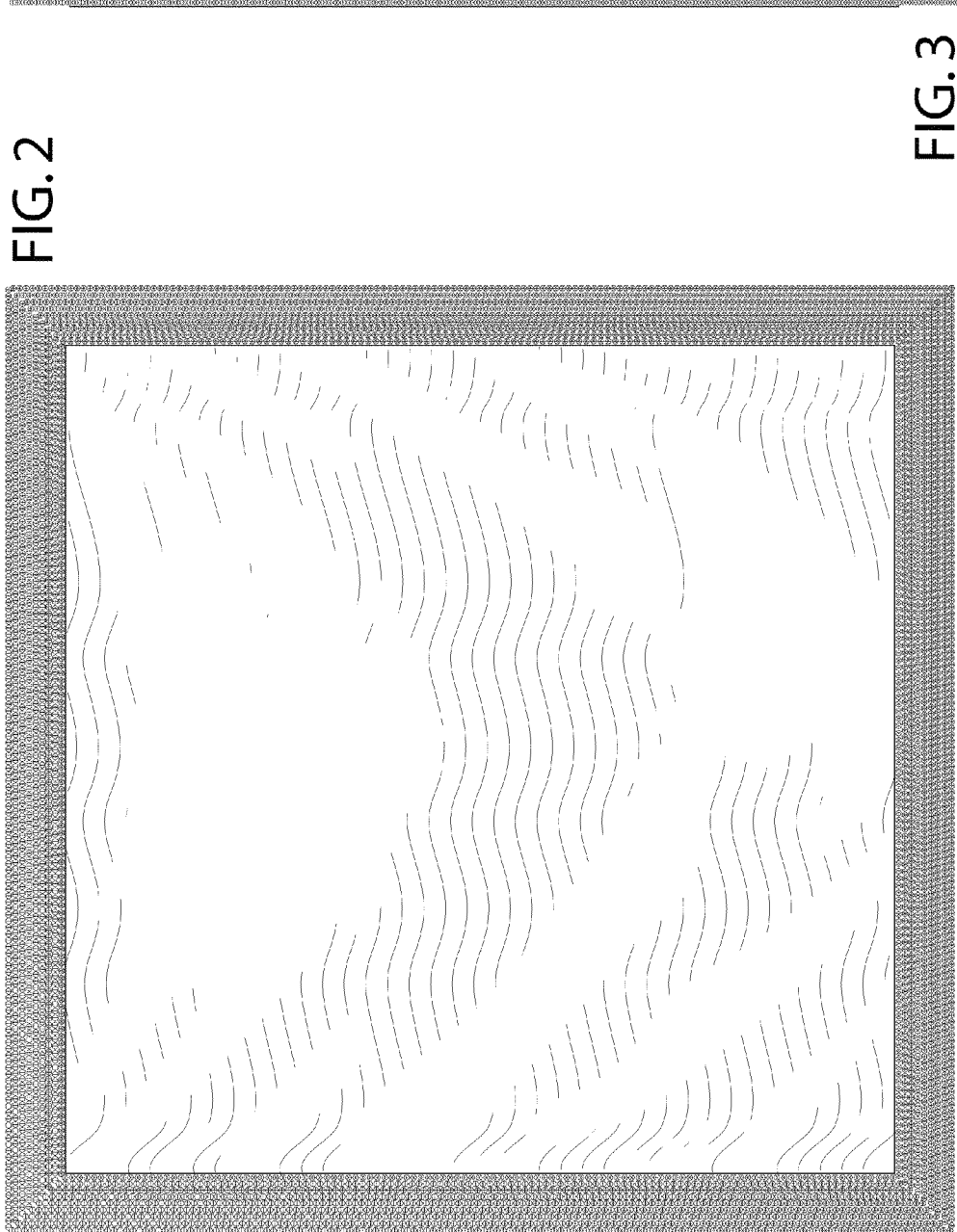

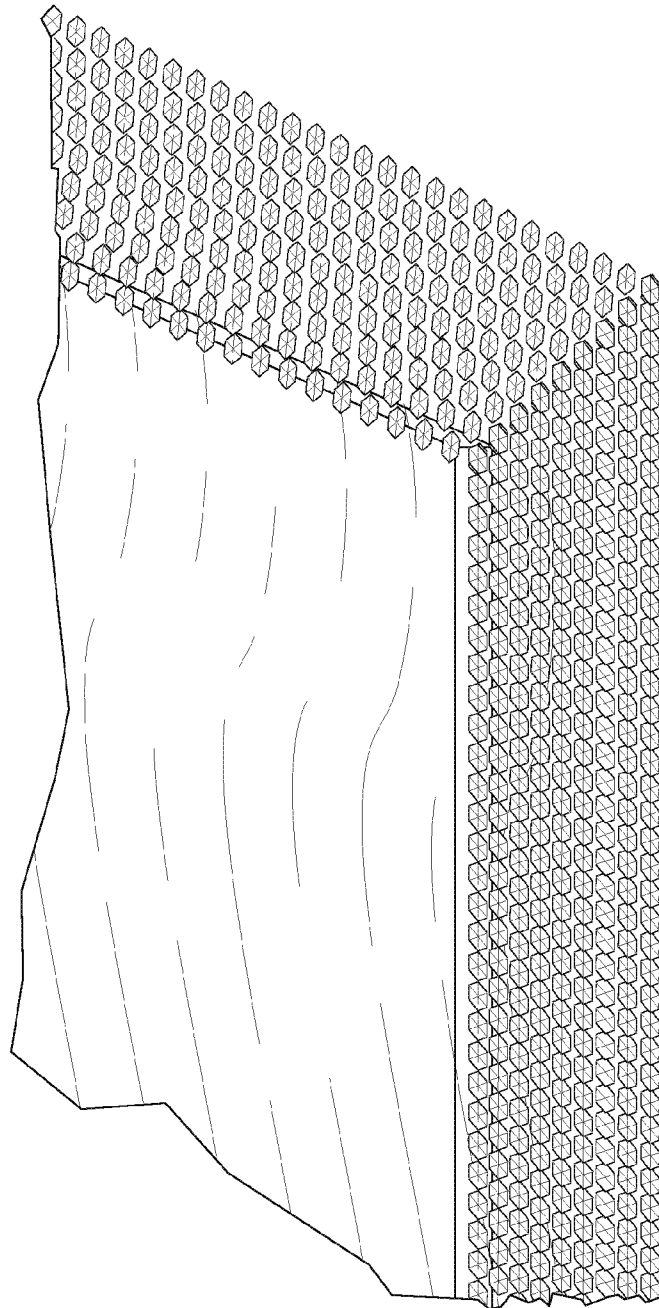
