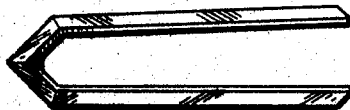
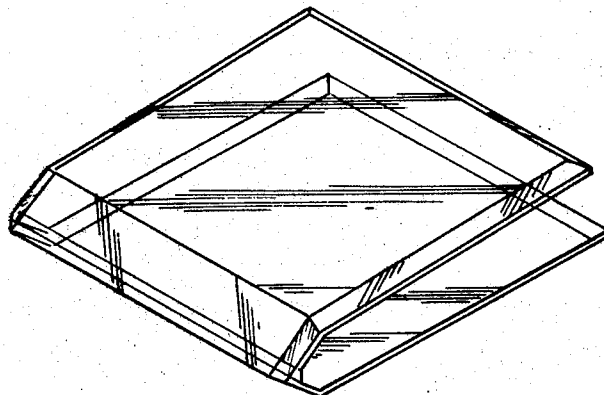

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the top, front and left side of a napkin clip showing my new design;

 FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof.



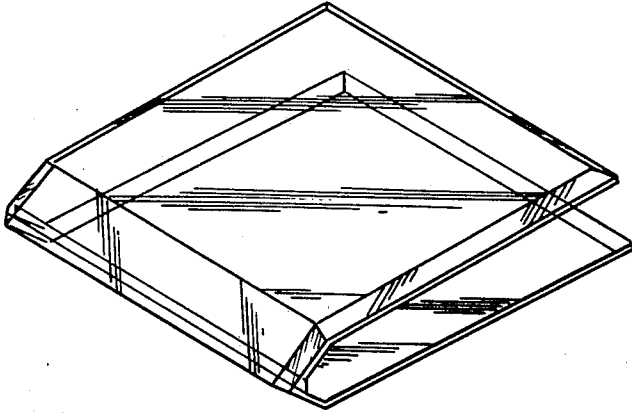

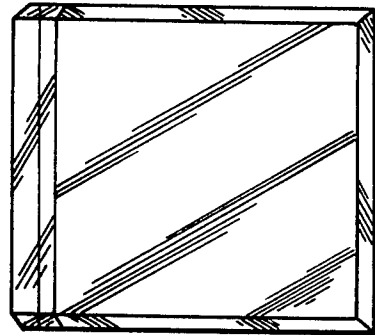

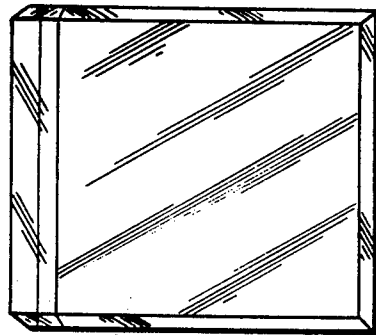
