

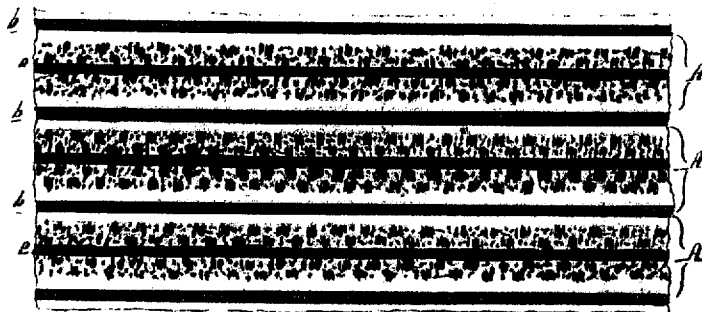

DESIGN FOR A STOCKING FABRIC.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

I, THOMAS DOLAN, of Philadelphia, county of Philadelphia, State of Pennsylvania, have invented or produced a Design for a Fabric for Cotton Hose, of which the following is a specification.

The figure in the accompanying drawings represents sufficient of a fabric for cotton hose to illustrate my design, the principal feature of which consists of a series of transverse stripes, A A, separated from each other by narrow transverse bars *b b*.

Each of the stripes A has a central bar, *e*, on each side of which is a row of spots, too clearly shown in the drawing to need description.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim—

The design for a fabric for cotton hose, substantially as described, and illustrated in and by the accompanying drawings.
